T.O. gallery to show works of Newlove

June 8 to July 15

One of Milton's own will showcase her work in a Toronto art gallery next month.

Artist Tina Newlove will have an exhibit at Yorkville's Leonardo Gallery from June 8 to July 15.

"They're pretty excited about my new work," Newlove said of the gallery's owners.

The show, entitled 'Post-it Notes, Forget-me-nots, Skeletons and Quiet Spots', will feature oil and mixed-media paintings, most of them connected in that they're based on Newlove's memories and subconscious.

Newlove, who lives in Guelph but maintains a studio in Campbellville, said her art is very feminine and somewhat surreal. Much of it is based on ideas rather than objects, and she tends to paint from her memory or subconscious rather than from photos.

"This gallery has been so supportive. Hopefully it (the exhibit) gets some attention," Newlove said.

The evening will feature familiar selections from Mamma Mia, Les Miserables, Cats, West Side Story and other favourite shows in a casual, pub night format under the leadership of


director Sonja van de Hoef.
