

Haydar keeps tearing it up in AHL playoffs

But Admirals' lengthy winning streak snapped in game two

The Milwaukee Admirals' winning ways were interrupted Saturday night, but their star Miltonian's production certainly wasn't.

Darren Haydar recorded a pair of powerplay assists in the second period of Calder Cup championship game-two action against the Hershey Bears to lift his league-leading playoff point total to 31.

Unfortunately, Milwaukee had its 10-game winning streak snapped, with a 6-3 setback, and now sits even at one win apiece with Hershey in the American Hockey League final — with game three not coming until Saturday, when the Bears begin their first of three games at home.

Enjoying his most productive post season to date in four years in the AHL, Haydar has a point in all but one of the Admirals' 17 playoff games so far and has a whopping 11 multi-point games this spring.

He's also now tied for second for the most goals ever scored in an AHL playoff campaign with 15, after scoring on a powerplay point blast late in the first period Friday to help Milwaukee to a 2-1 series-opening victory.

The blueline deposit marked his third game-winning goal in as many outings, and his fifth overall of the playoffs.

Jr. Red Sox rally to upstage Burlington

Well-rounded effort leads to key win over highly-touted Bulls

The Junior Red Sox donned their proverbial rally caps to prevail in their biggest home-field test to date.

Within the friendly confines of Brian Best Park Sunday afternoon, Milton battled back from a 5-0 deficit to outdistance the highly-touted Burlington Bulls 10-7.

The hard-fought win pushed the Red Sox to 4-1-1 on the year.

Playing for the first time in nearly two weeks — following a tournament-related cancellation and couple of rain-outs — the local juniors out-hit their guests 11-8 and enjoyed a big three-hit, four RBI day from third baseman Brian Hunter.

Milton scored three times in the seventh inning to take the lead for good, and had three-run second and third innings as well to turn the tide on the Bulls.

Hopes for victory looked rather bleak early on, as Burlington jumped up ahead with a few runs and starting pitcher Sean Mathé went down with re-aggravated knee trouble while attempting to make a ground out himself.

However, reliever P.J. McColl settled into a groove after a somewhat shaky start and held the visitors scoreless throughout the last four frames — enjoying near-flawless fielding along the way.

Defensive efforts were highlighted

by a seventh-inning double play — with two runs aboard — and a huge diving catch by left fielder Chris Shadlock in the ninth.

Nick Vipond stood out with two RBI, while Nick Mazzorato scored

three times.

The Red Sox are in Oakville tomorrow night and wrap up a two-game road trip June 15 in Mississauga. Their next home game is slated for June 18 at 1 p.m. against Mississauga.

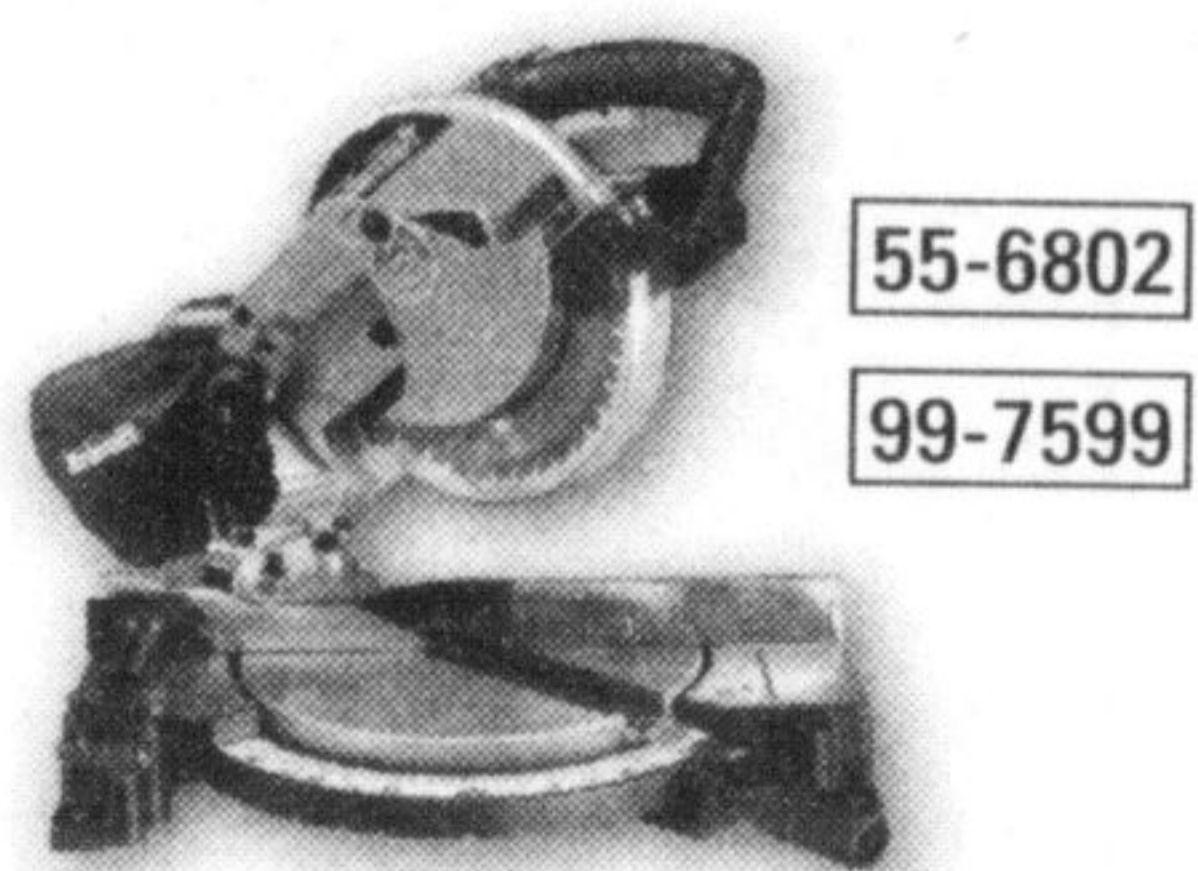

SAFETY RECALL MASTERCRAFT MITRE SAW, MITRE SAW WITH LASER LINE AND MITRE SAW WITH STAND

Canadian Tire is voluntarily recalling two Mastercraft 10" Compound Mitre Saws, two Mastercraft 10" Compound Mitre Saws with Laser Line and Mastercraft 10" Compound Mitre Saw with Stand (Canadian Tire product numbers 55-6802, 55-6895, 55-6893, 55-6821 and 99-7599) due to a potential safety concern. It has been determined that due to a manufacturing defect, the aluminium cast pivot joint that connects the base of the saw and the head assembly (containing the blade) may crack under extreme pressure or force causing a potential safety concern.

While Canadian Tire is not aware of any incidents causing injury, there have been 13 in which the aluminium cast joint pivot cracked. In four of these instances, the pivot head broke causing the head to detach from the base.

Canadian Tire is asking customers to discontinue the use of these products immediately and to return the products to Canadian Tire for a refund.

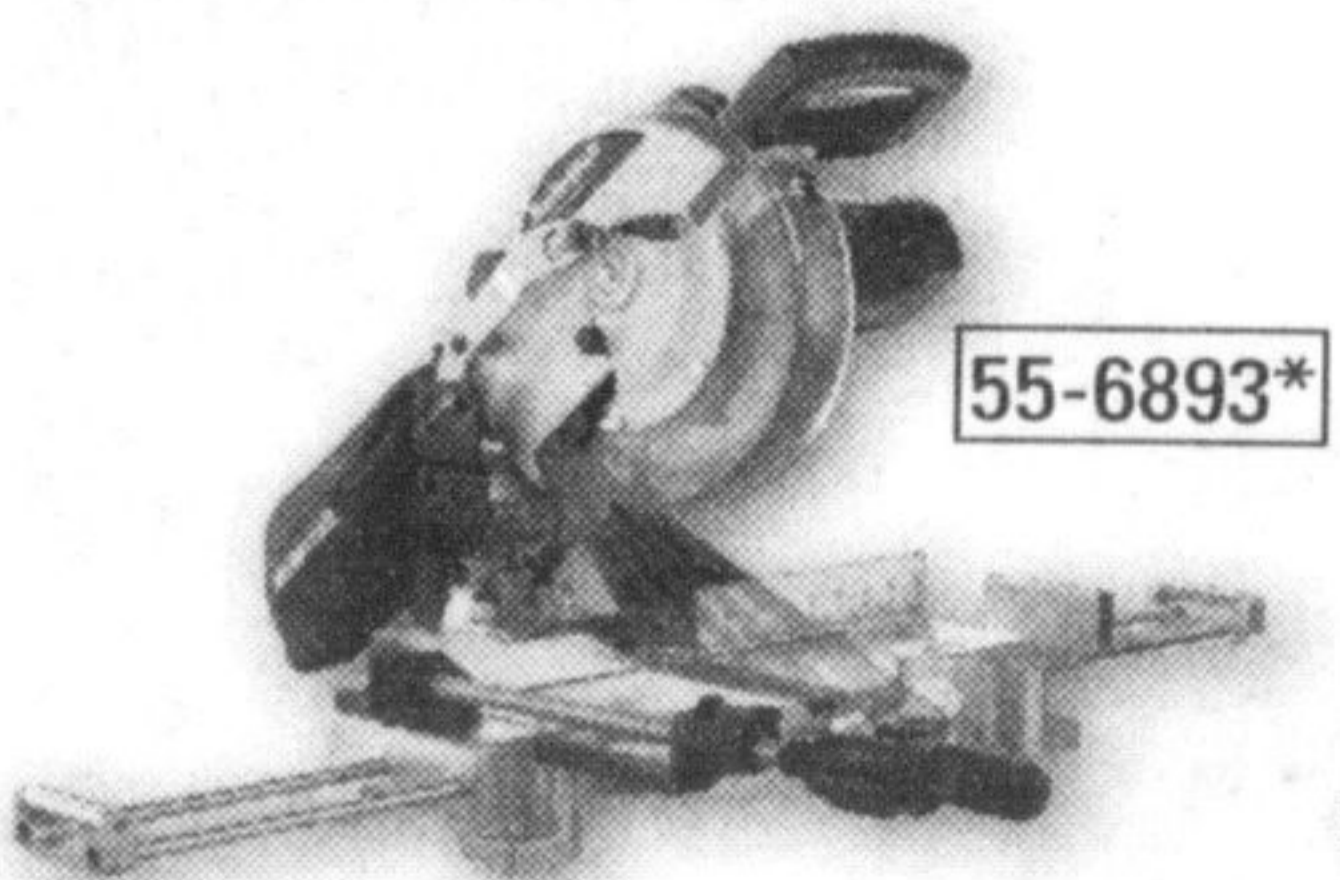

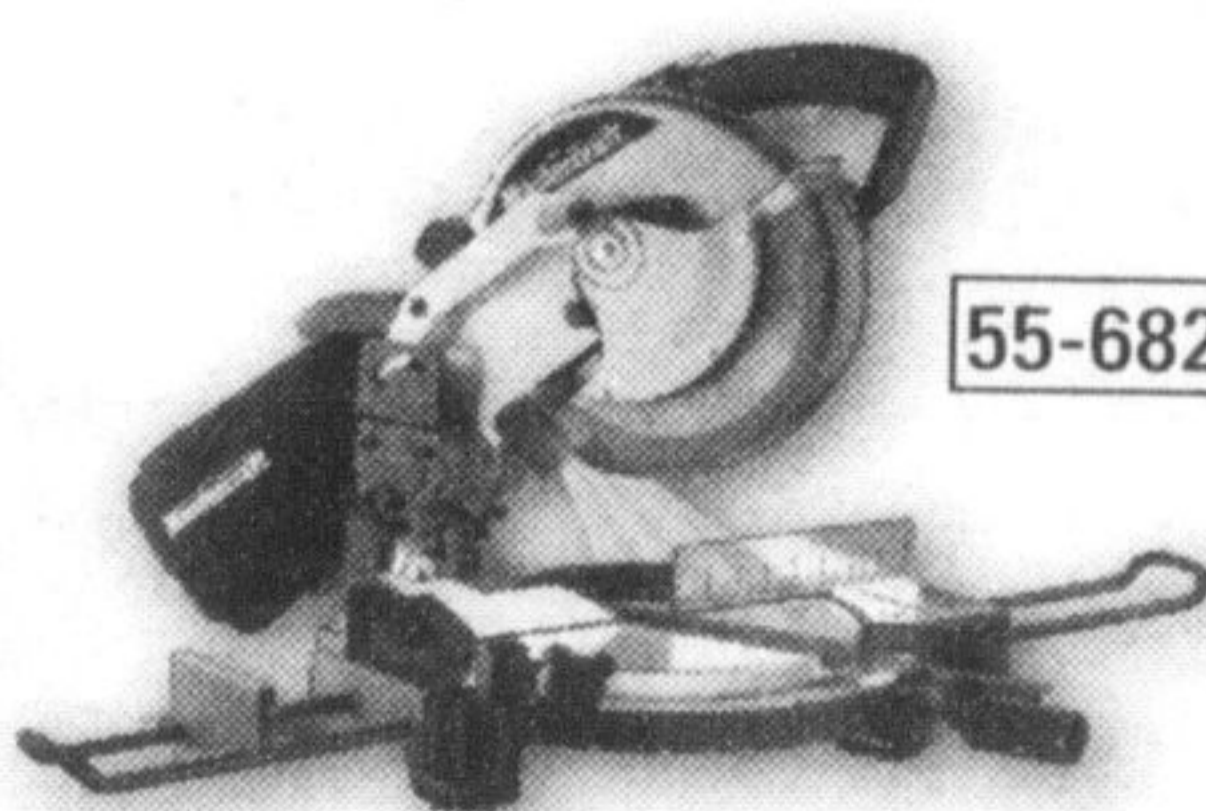

How the unit can be identified:

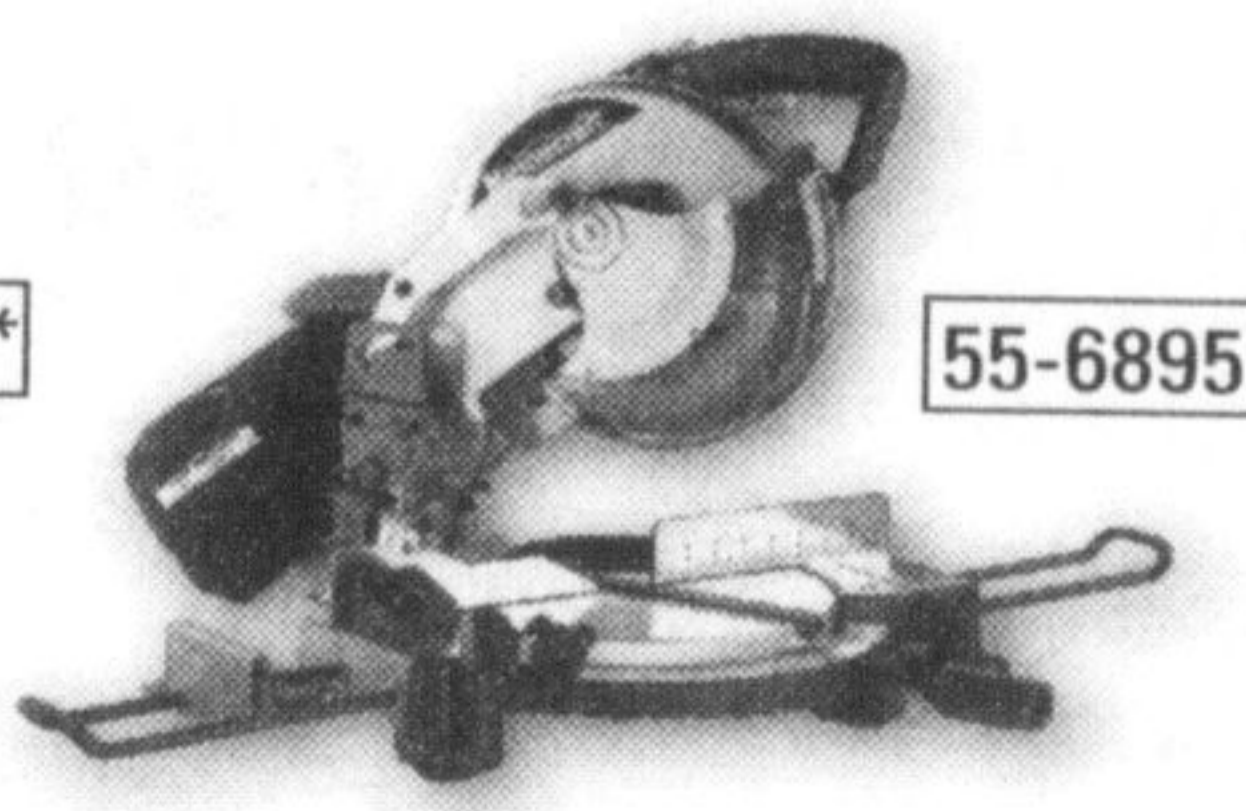
