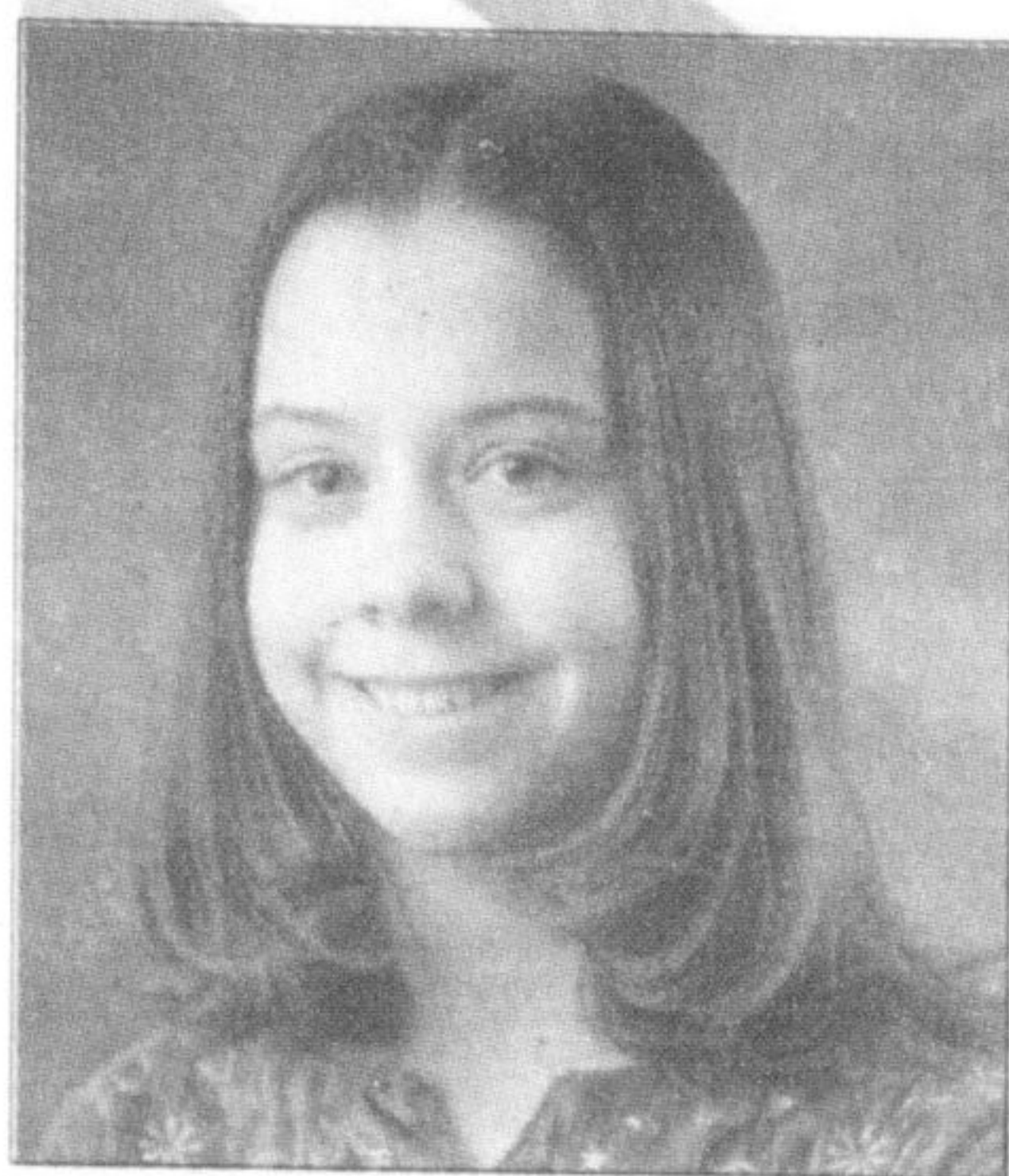


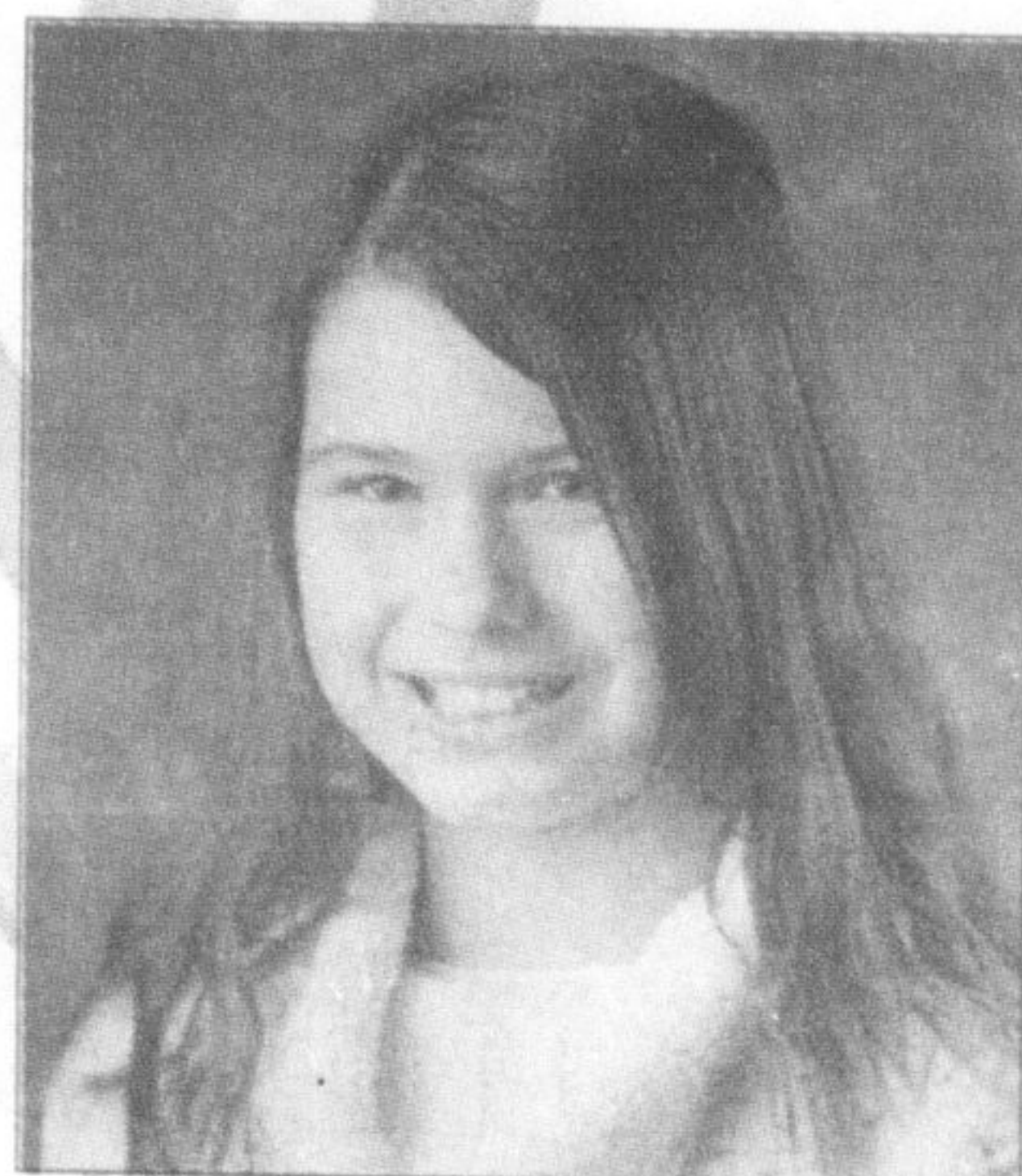
# Celebration of Student Excellence

President of the student council and an active member of the band, Kelly manages to balance a hectic schedule and still maintain an easy-going and positive attitude.



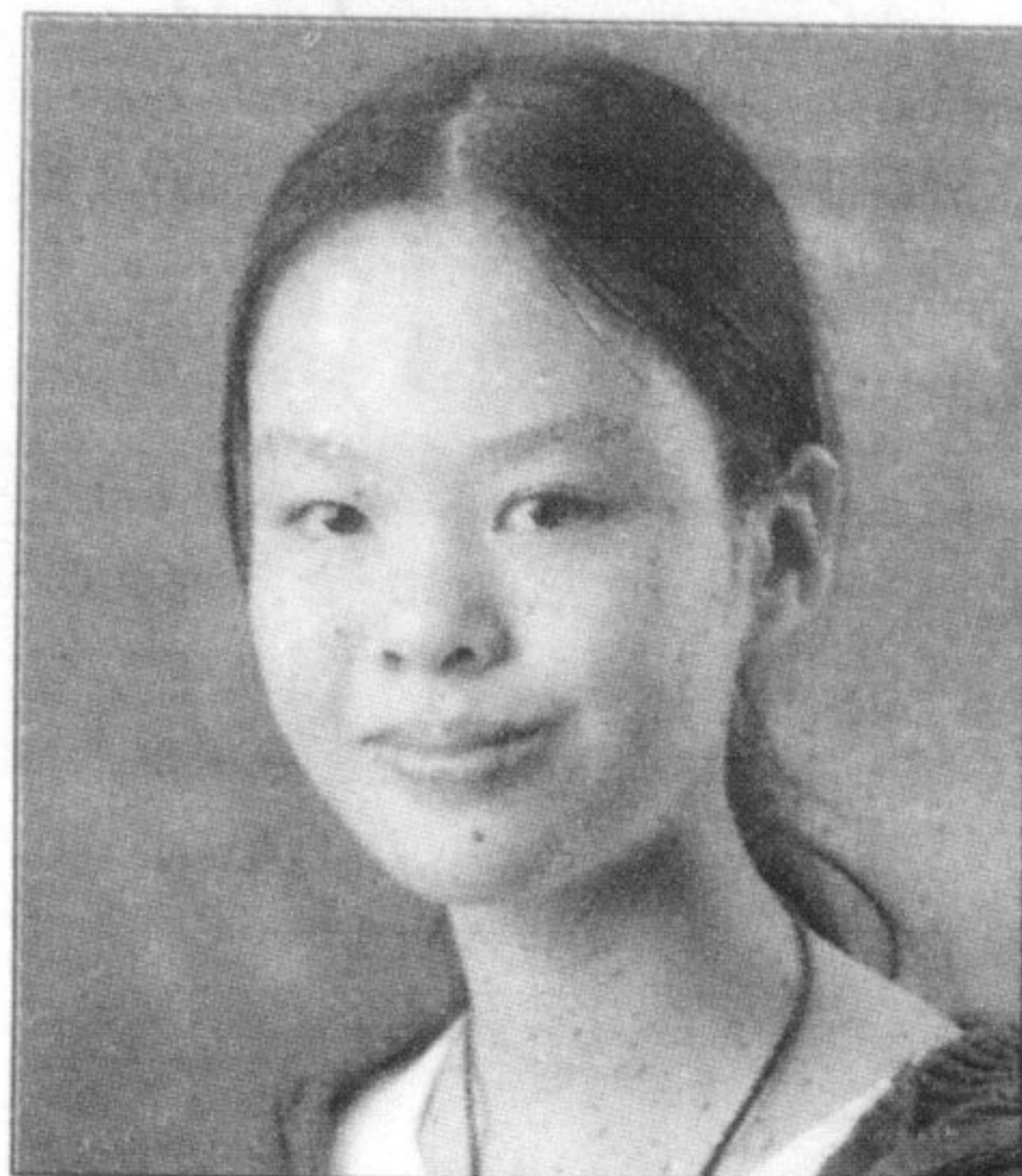
Elise Kollenhoven

Elise is a talented athlete and member of the student forum. She has an excellent academic record and possesses exemplary learning skills and great citizenship in all she does.



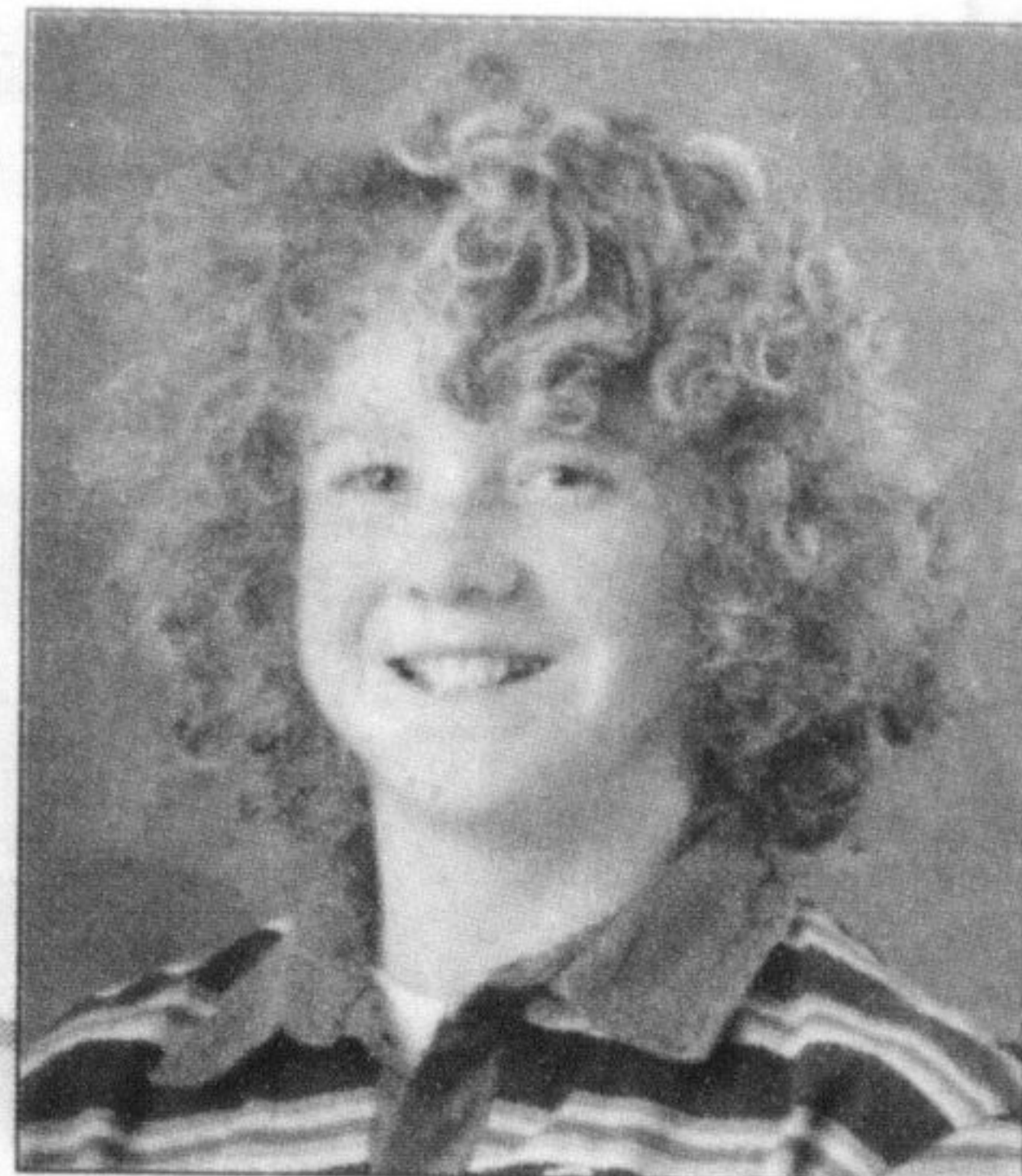
Kristina Luce

Kristina is a wonderful helper of younger students, as well as being a multi-sport athlete, band member and honour student — making her as well-rounded a student as they come.



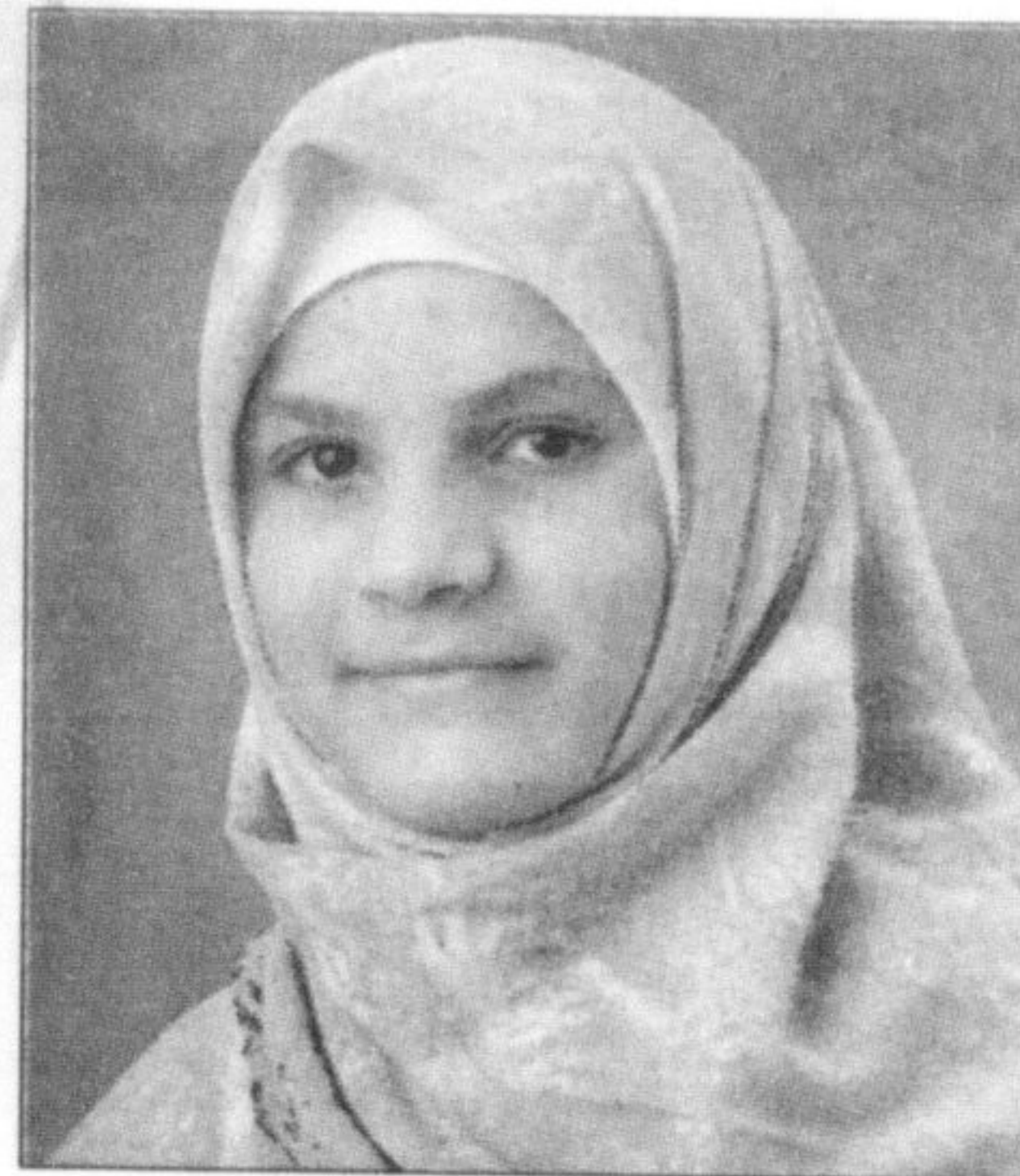
Serena Ly

Serena keeps busy as a member of the band, art club and student council. Her dedication and determination make her an ideal role model for fellow students.



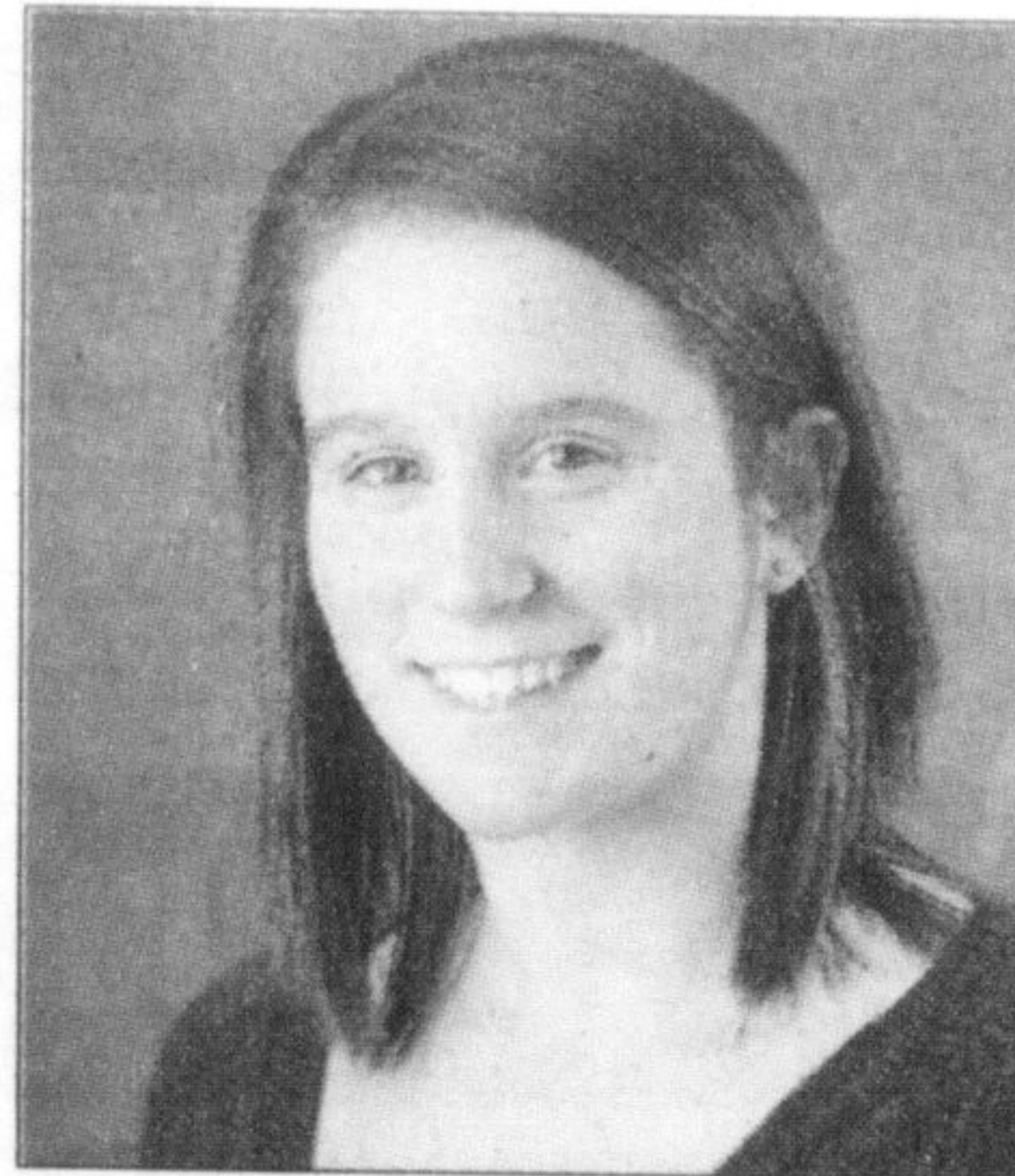
Josh Searle

Josh is a quiet leader who's well respected by students and teachers alike. He's highly involved in extra-curricular activities and consistently enjoys a high academic standing.



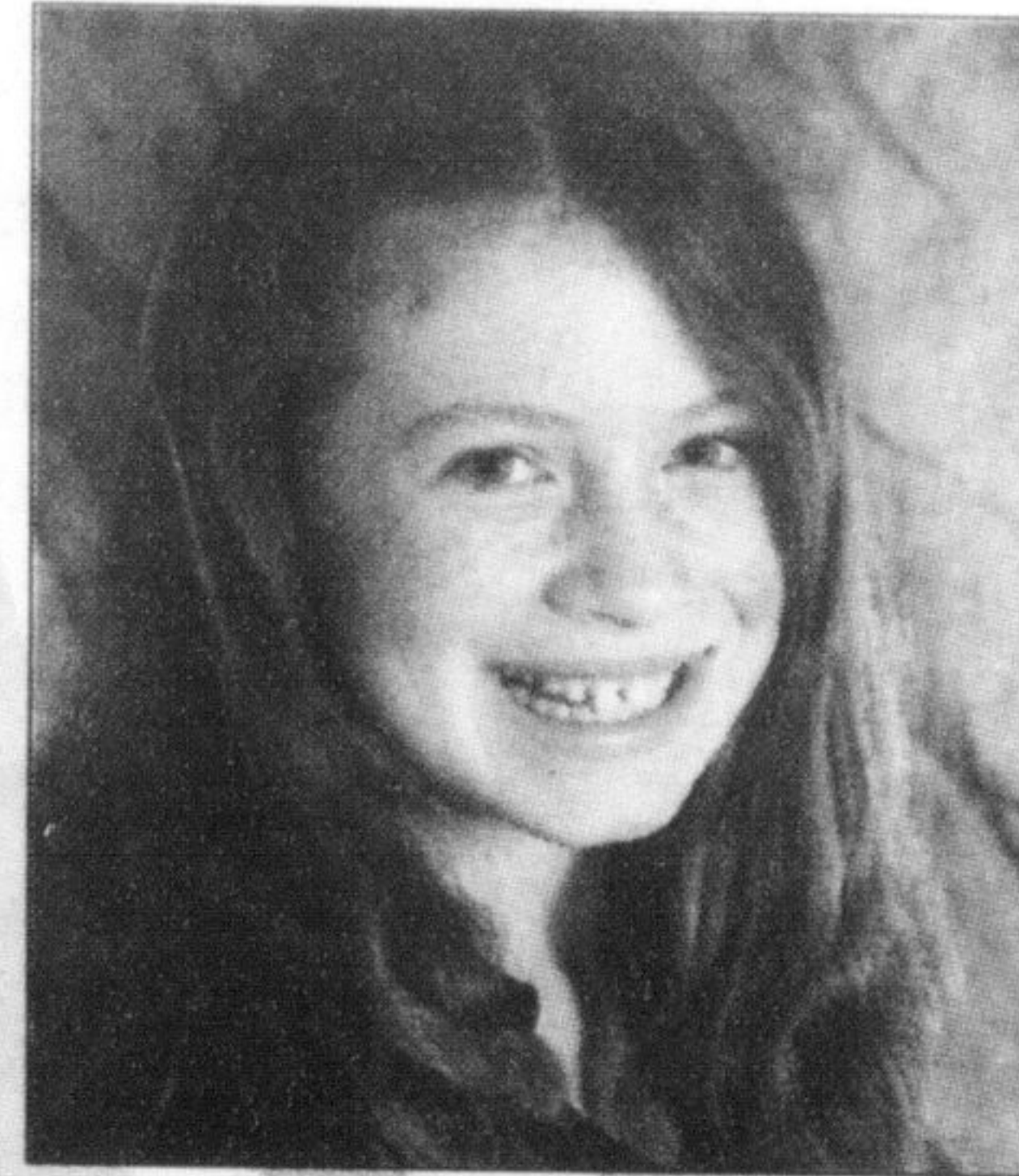
Zyenab Syed

An honours student, Dani was a passionate member of the school's hurricane relief building project in Grenada and has been pivotal in setting up the peer/mentor program.

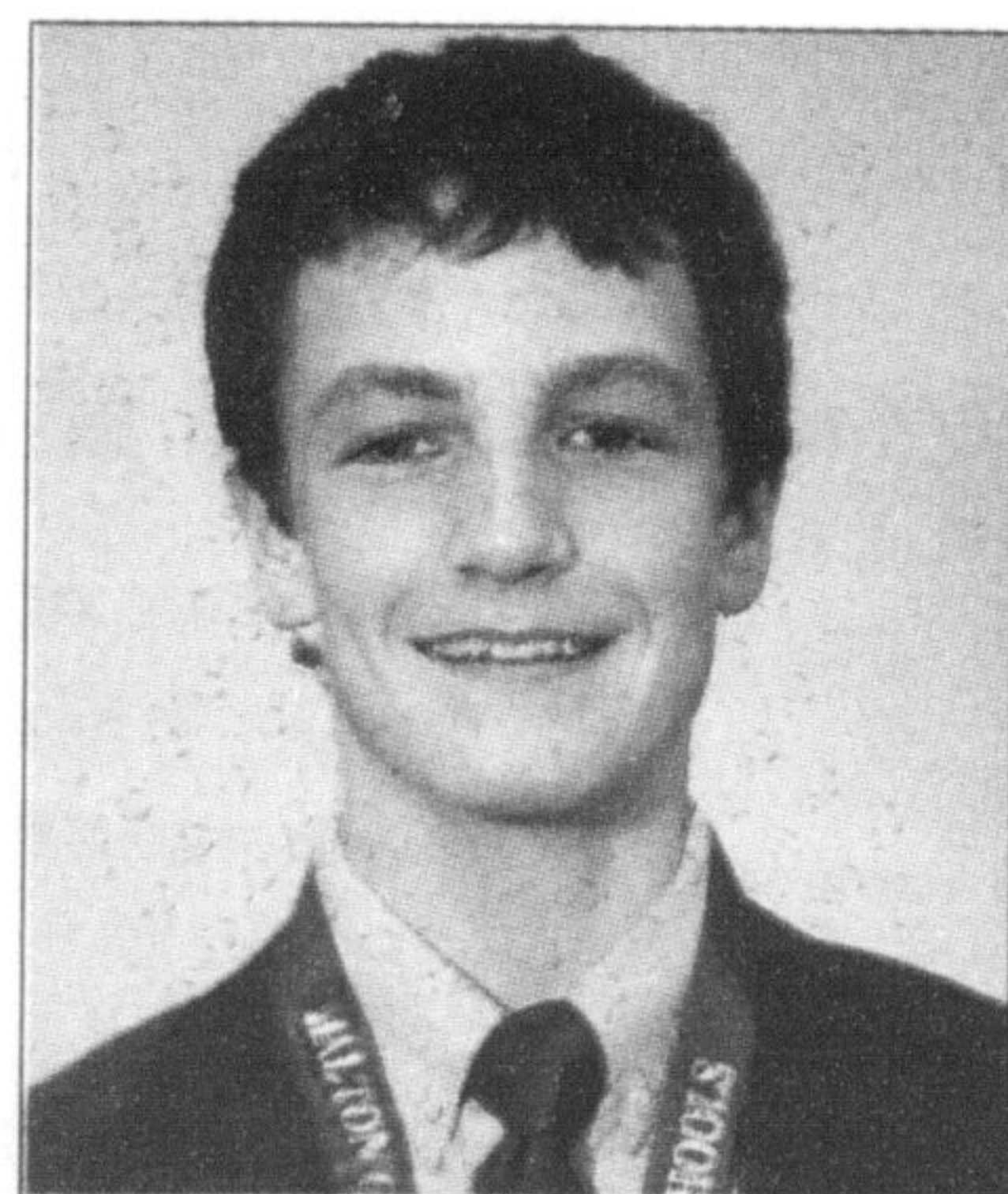


Darby Wood

Darby exemplifies many outstanding characteristics. Along with being an excellent athlete, she's a strong student and is kind and friendly toward her peers.

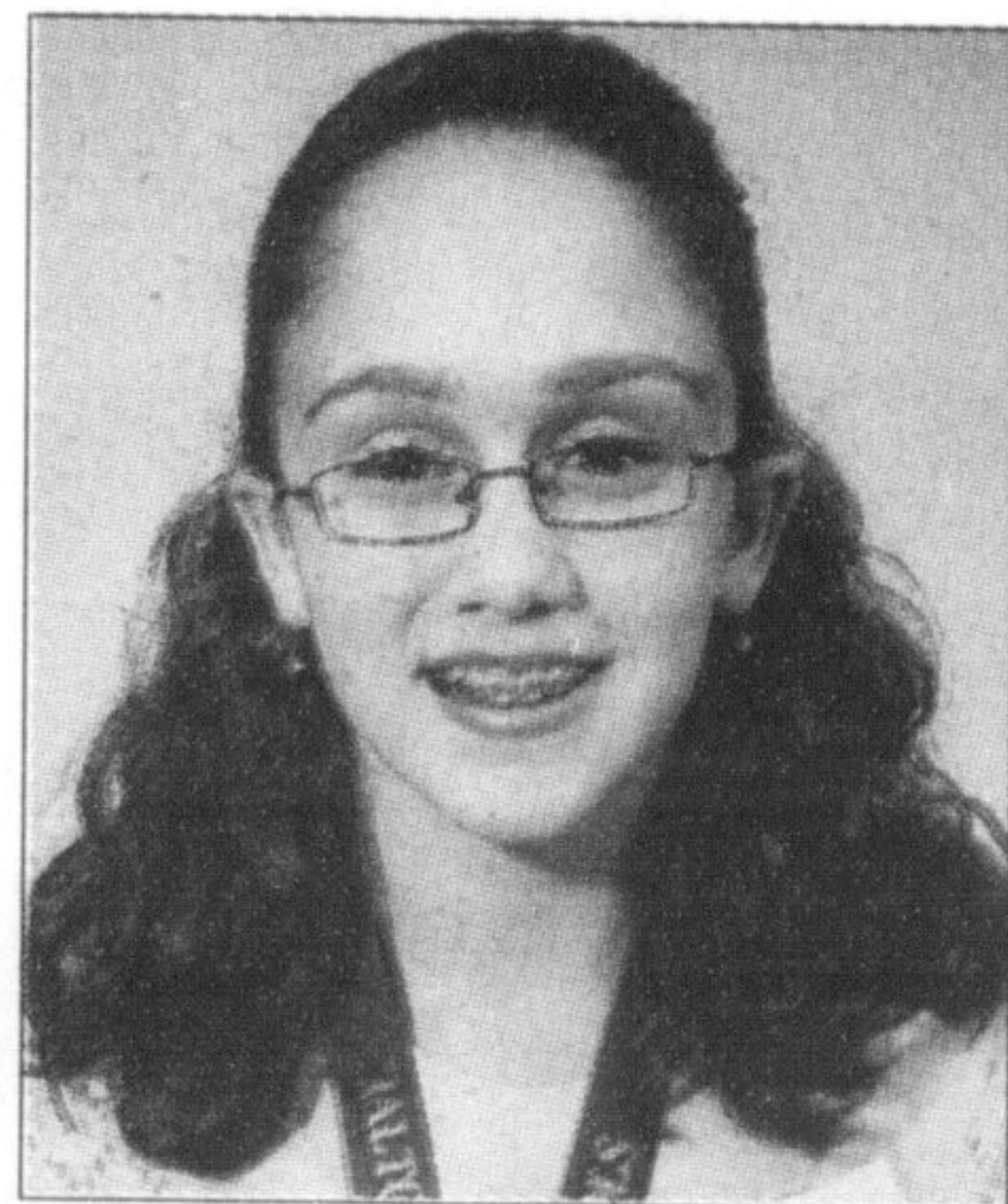
## Sharing the Spirit Student Awards of Excellence

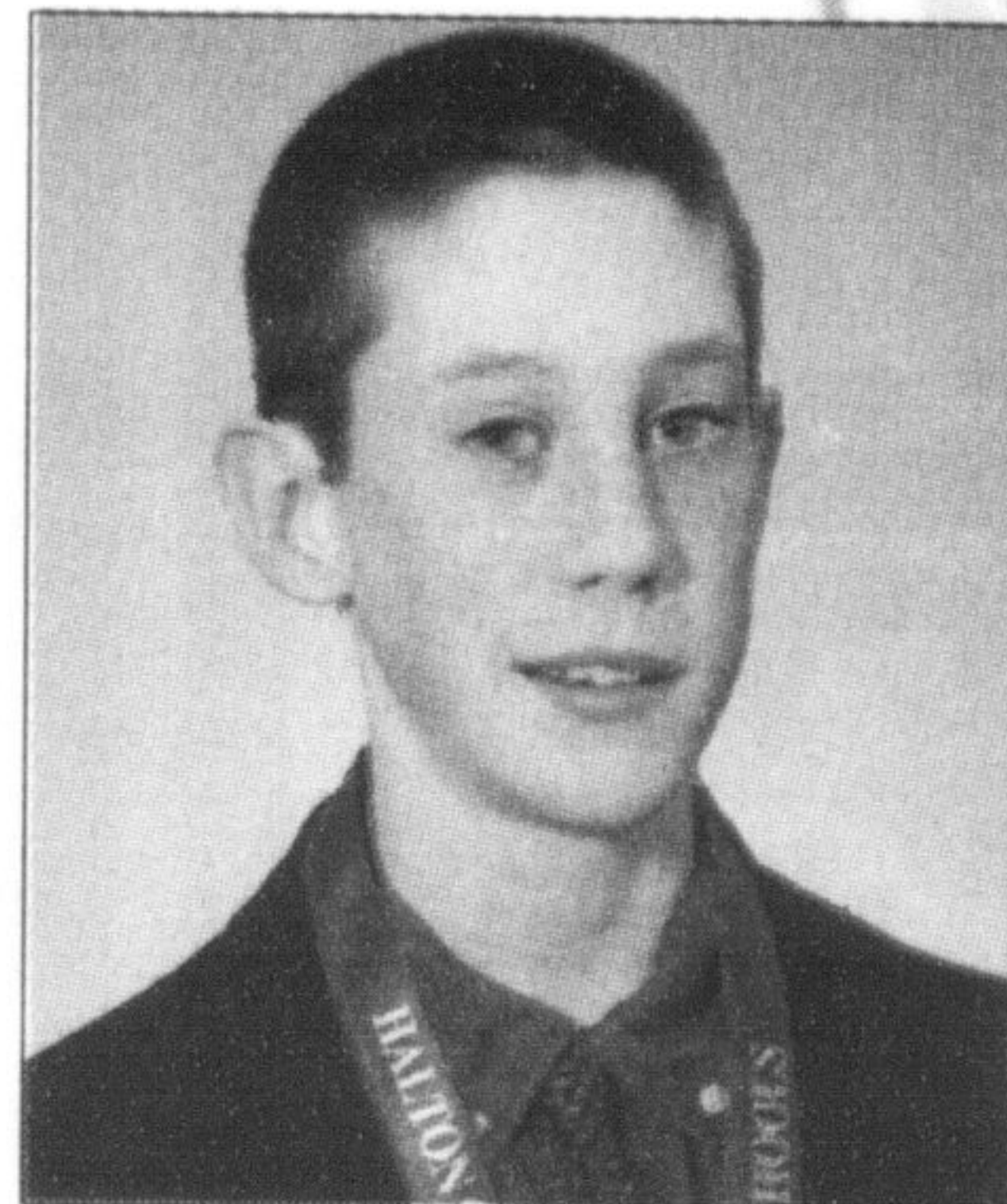
Scott Dermott

An accomplished athlete and strong student, Scott was selected for his Christian attitude toward others and the diligence in which he applies himself to his work.



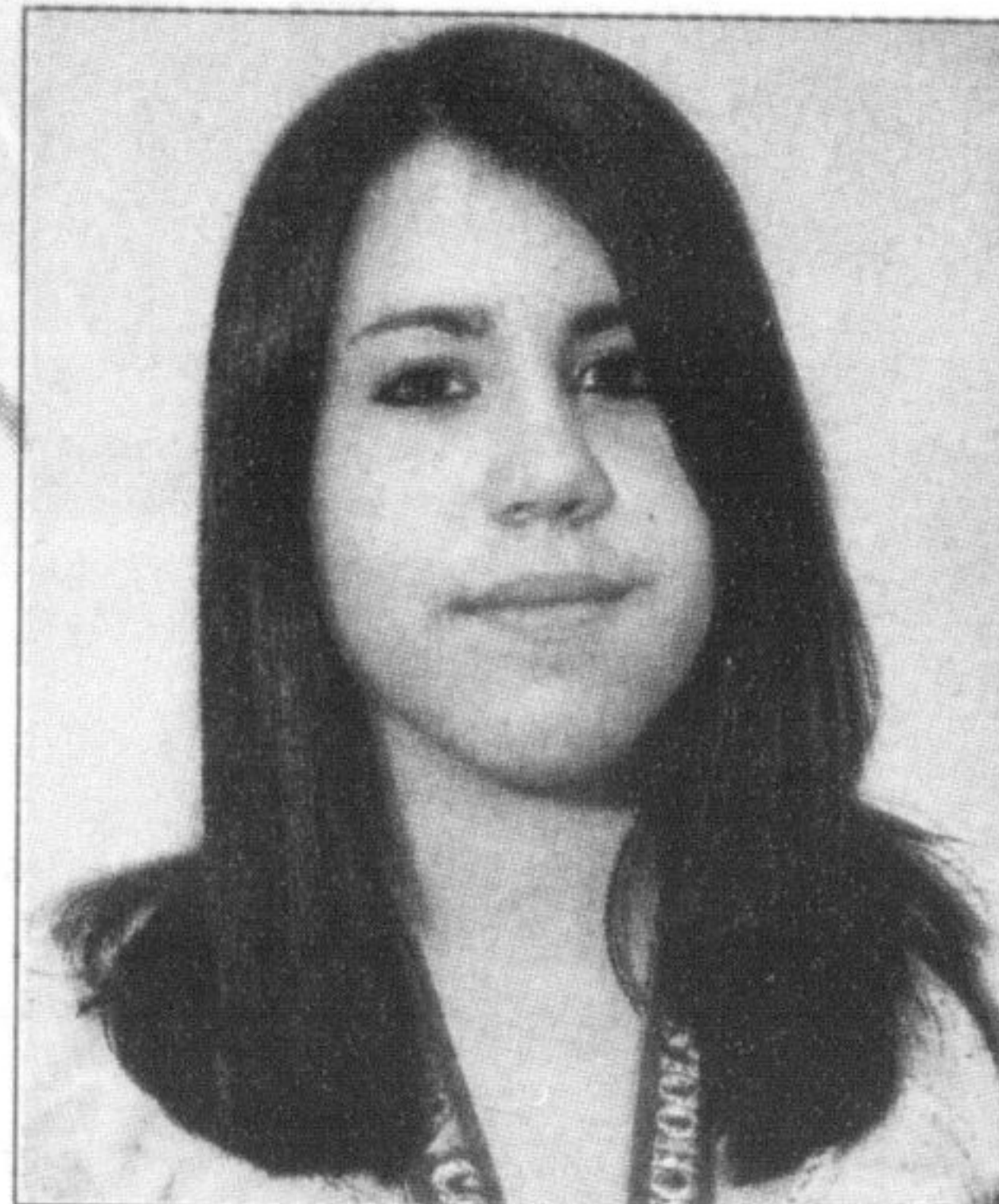
Christina LaCavera
