Banged Around, but Not Broken

I love the summertime!

Fishing, camping, picnics, barbecues, trips to the beach – all are highlights of the summer for me! But with the warmer weather and the tendency to eat outdoors, the potential to break dishes increases. For some, paper plates are the remedy, others have graduated to space-age plastic, while still others use more traditional fare. If you have ever dropped a dish and had it fracture into a million tiny pieces, you will know not only the awkwardness of the moment but also the difficulty of separating the tiny shards of glass from the strewn food.

I hate breaking dishes!

In the mid-1950's, Corning Scientist, Dr. Eugene Stookey, discovered a new material --by accident, it seems.

Stookey was working on photosensitive glass when he realized an oven temperature controller had malfunctioned. He noted the higher oven temperature, and expected to

discover liquid glass when he opened the oven door. Instead, he found that the solid glass had actually turned from transparent to white. He removed it from the oven and dropped it, due to the intense heat. He was astounded to see that the glass didn't break.

As a direct spin-off of the space program was a unique line of cooking utensils was introduced in 1958 -- Corningware.

The introduction of Corningware provided a new dimension to cookware because it could withstand use -- and abuse -- that few other glass or ceramic (and even metals) could withstand.

Likewise, the Apostle Paul uses the illustration of Christians being made of the "Corningware" of his day, and how it can withstand the use -- and abuse -- that this world can place upon it. And more importantly, Paul shares with us that it's not what we

are made of that is important, but what's inside of us that counts.

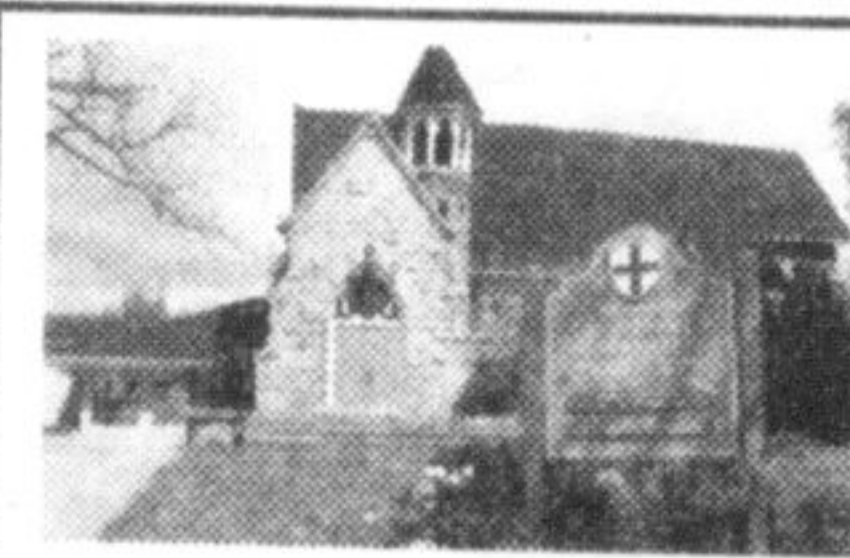

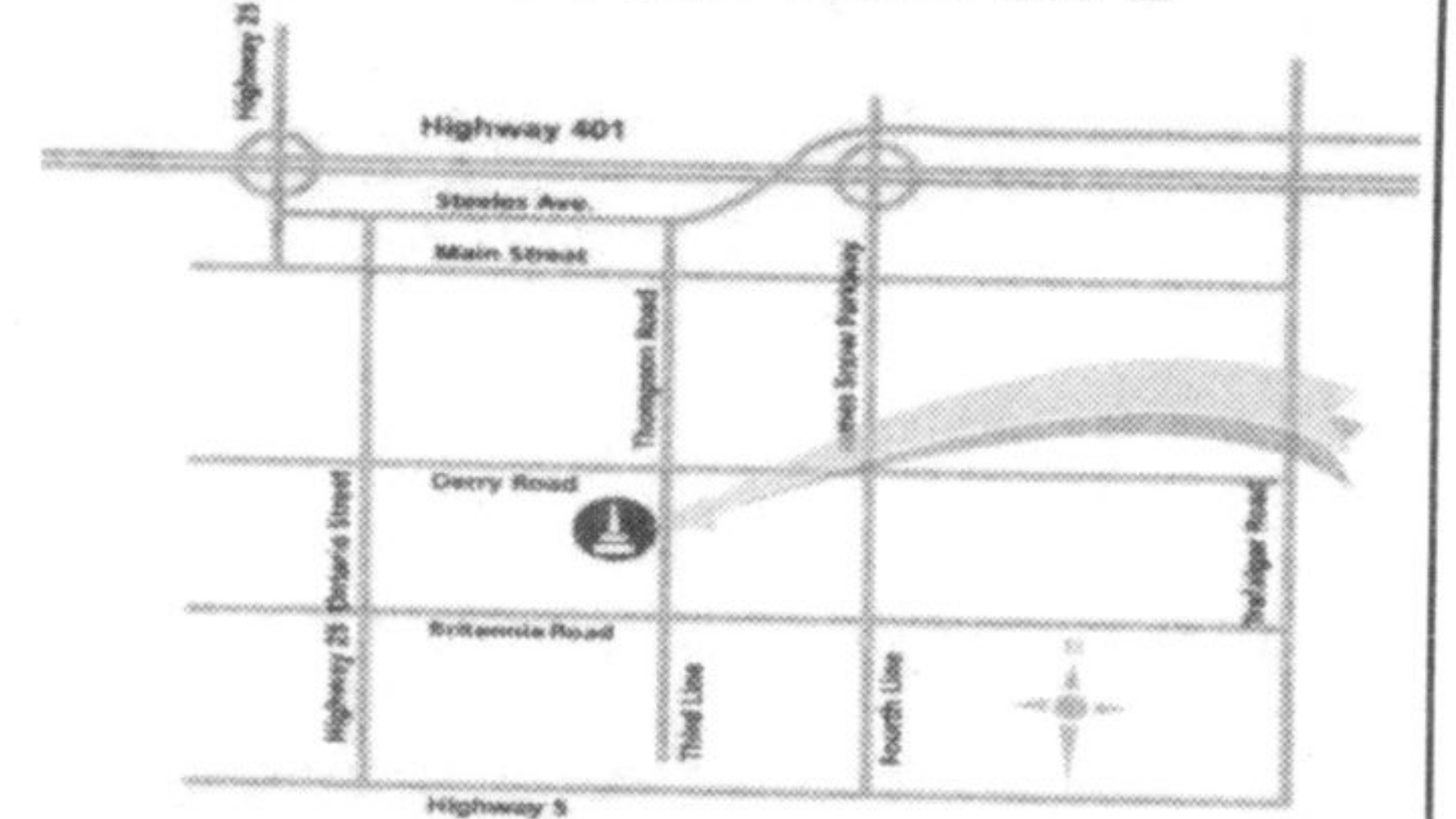
