Vandals target backyards

Halton Regional Police are investigating five separate incidents of vandalism.

Overnight last Friday, suspects entered the backyards of two homes on White Drive and two on Lyons Court. Vandals threw patio furniture, barbecues and cement statues into the swimming pools, causing damage to one of the pool liners. Several patio lights were also smashed.

A fifth incident took place on Marcellus Avenue around the same time.

Date set for pit bull hearing

A hearing that'll decide whether a pit bull that bit a Milton boy last summer will be destroyed has been adjourned until August 31.

The date was set July 10 at Ontario Provincial Offences Court in Milton.

An application is before the court requesting that the pit bull, owned by Scarborough resident Jackeline Perez, be ordered destroyed. An interim court order is currently in effect, which places strict conditions on the dog including that it not leave its property.

Nine-year-old Chazz Steward was bitten on his hand a year ago by the male dog while walking past its house — owned by Perez's parents — at the corner of Dixon Drive and Pearson Way. The dog hadn't been muzzled in accordance with Milton's animal control bylaw, nor was it licenced.

Charges were laid against Jackeline and her mother, Bianca Perez, under the Dog Owners' Liability Act and the animal control bylaw respectively. Each pleaded guilty and paid a fine.

School theft case remanded

A Halton Hills woman charged with defrauding three north Halton school councils of about \$30,000, including the councils of two Milton schools, will return to court August 16.

Brenda Pickering, 43, was charged in February with three counts of theft over \$5,000 and uttering a forged document. The return date was set Wednesday at Ontario Court of Justice in Milton, where the next appearance will be held.

From 2002 to 2005, Pickering served as the volunteer treasurer for the

school councils at J.M. Denyes and W.I. Dick as well as at Georgetown's Stewarttown Public School. It was during that time that the money went missing from the accounts of the three school councils.

A police investigation was initiated after a complaint by the Halton District School Board that irregularities had been discovered in the school councils' accounting practices.

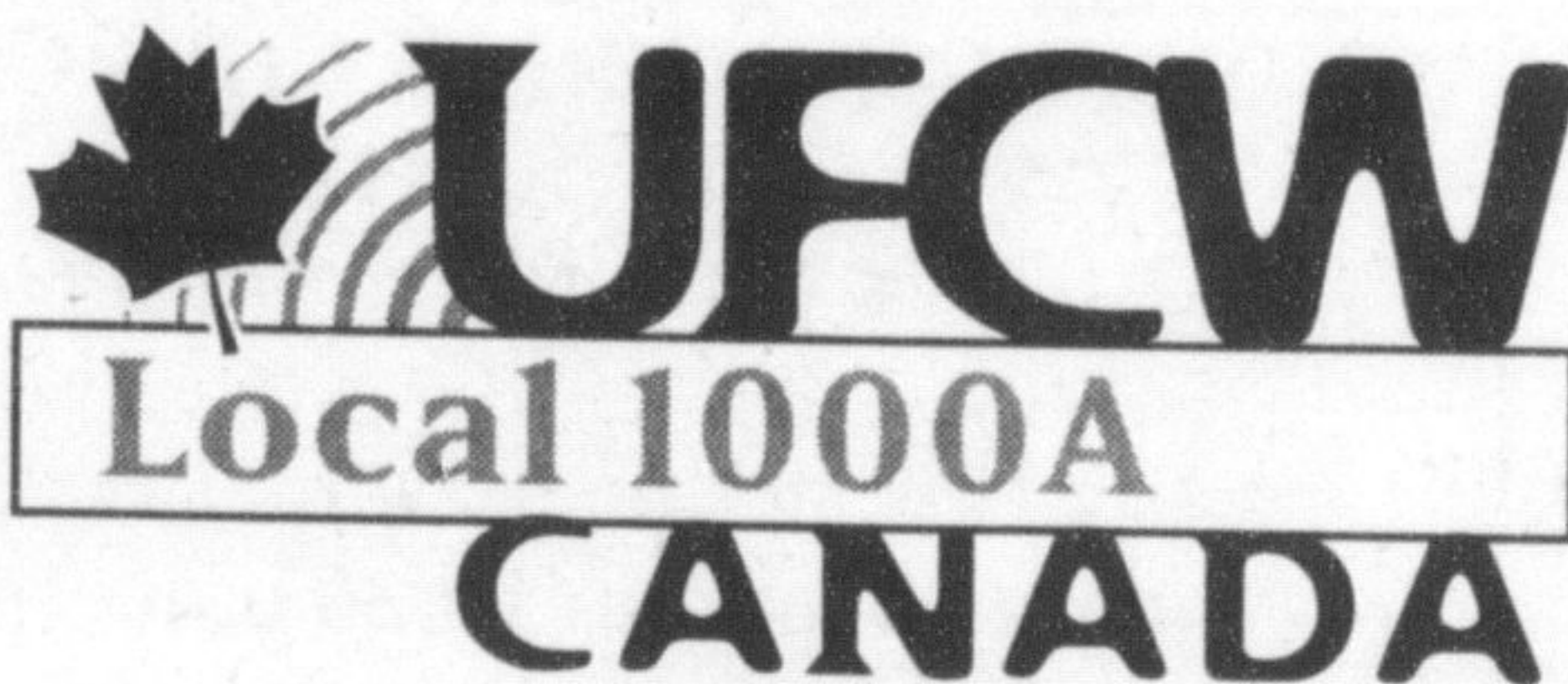
About \$10,000 went missing from J.M. Denyes and about \$5,500 from W.I. Dick.
