# Region begins in-house commuting program

The Region is launching its Smart Commute Halton program to help reduce local traffic congestion and improve air quality.

The new venture is for employees of the Halton Regional Centre and the Woodlands Operation Centre and is designed to reduce single occupant vehicle trips to and from work.

"The goal of Smart Commute Halton is to encourage employees of Halton Region to try alternate modes of transportation to work," said CAO Brent Marshall.

"Halton Region is implementing improved transportation choices such as a carpool ride match program, preferential carpool parking and an emergency ride home program."

But local residents can benefit from the Smart Commute initiative as well by visiting [www.smartcommute.ca](http://www.smartcommute.ca) and checking out the Carpool Zone, a ride matching service.

Regional Chairman Joyce Savoline said while Smart Commute Halton is a demonstration program, she noted it

will be used as an example for initiatives that can be implemented at other regional facilities, local municipalities and employers within Halton.

"I encourage all Halton businesses and residents to join Smart Commute Halton and help reduce traffic congestion, smog and greenhouse gas emissions," she said.

Smart Commute Halton comes as part of the transportation demand reduction program called the Smart Commute Initiative, which forms a partnership with the cities of Hamilton, Mississauga and Toronto, the regions of Durham, Peel and York and Transport Canada.

To support sustainable transportation solutions, the Region is undertaking the development of a Transportation Management Association (TMA) across Halton.

TMA's, which offer services like carpool ride matching and an emergency ride home program, are being developed and implemented across the GTA.
