

Cars damaged in vandalism rash

At least four vehicles were vandalized overnight July 26 on two streets in town.

Police said unknown suspects — expected to be the same for each incident — smashed the windshields or windows of two vehicles on Holly Avenue and two on nearby Harrison Road.

It appears the culprit stood on the roof and kicked in the windows, police said.

The damaged cars were a 2002 Mazda, a 1999 Oldsmobile, a 1999 Daewoo and a 2003 Chevrolet Cavalier.

The value of damage to each of the vehicles ranges from about \$300 to \$500. Police are investigating.

Copper cable stolen

Once again, the Hydro One compound on Main Street has been the scene of a metal theft.

Police said that overnight July 31, two reels of copper cable were stolen by unknown suspects after they forced their way through the locked main gate.

One reel contained 8,000 pounds of cable, while the

other was wound with 7,000 pounds.

In the past year, Hydro One has been broken into six times, with copper wire stolen in each incident.

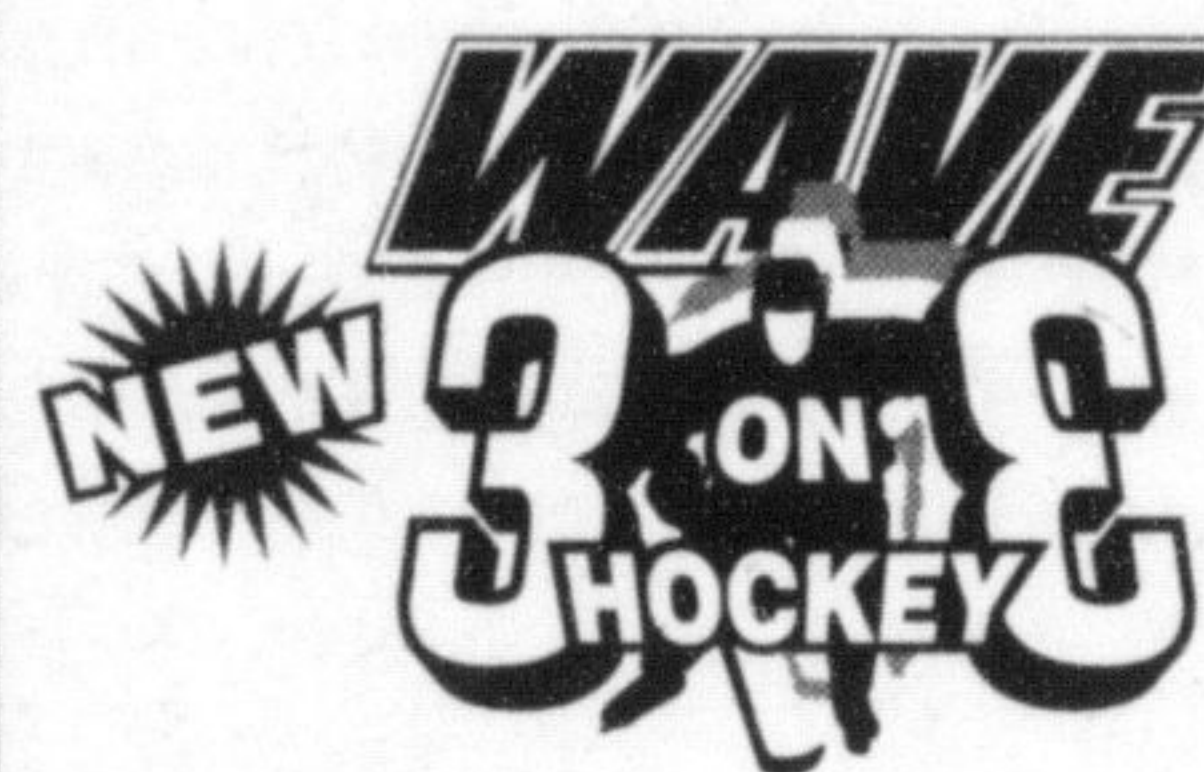

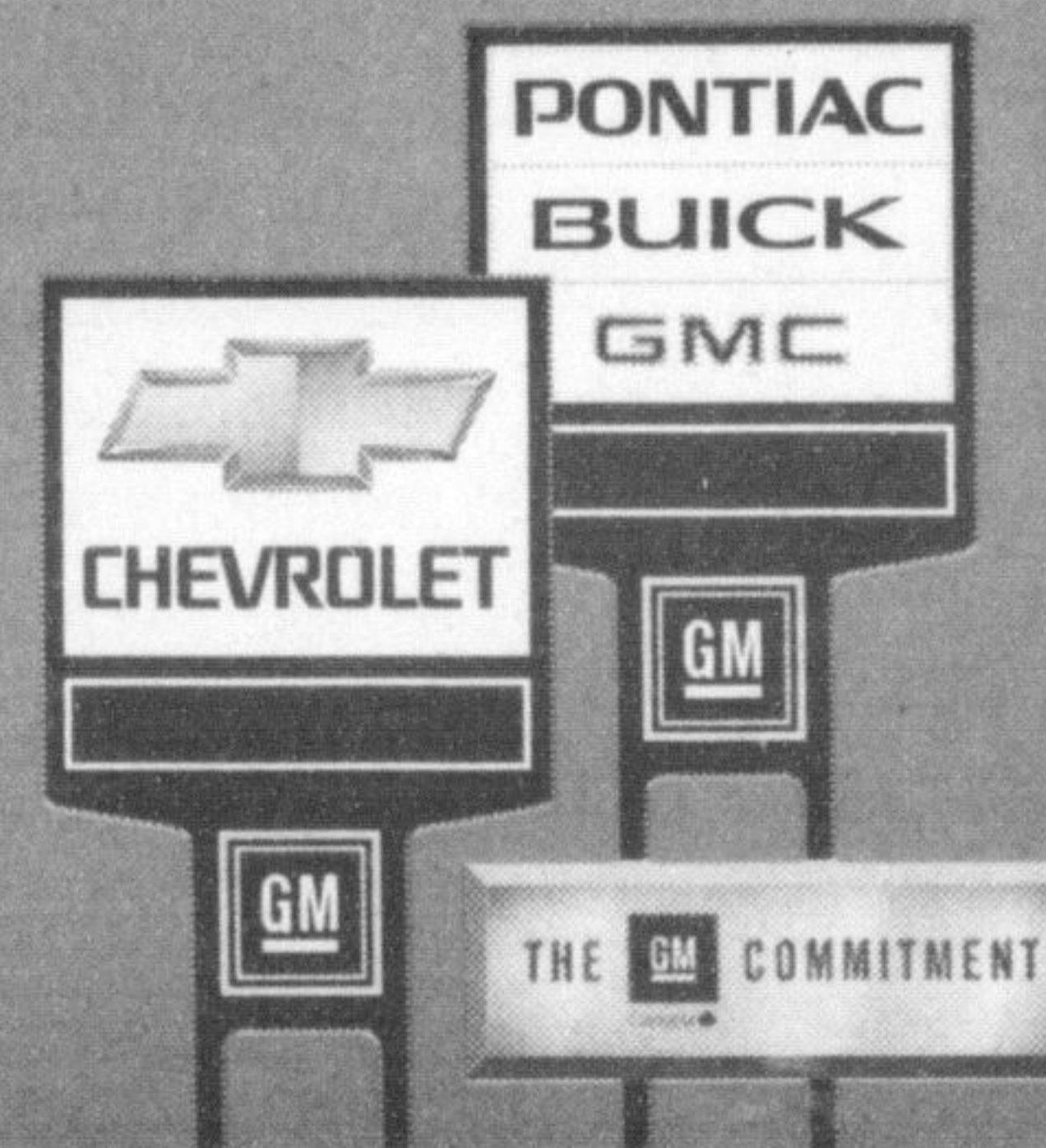
