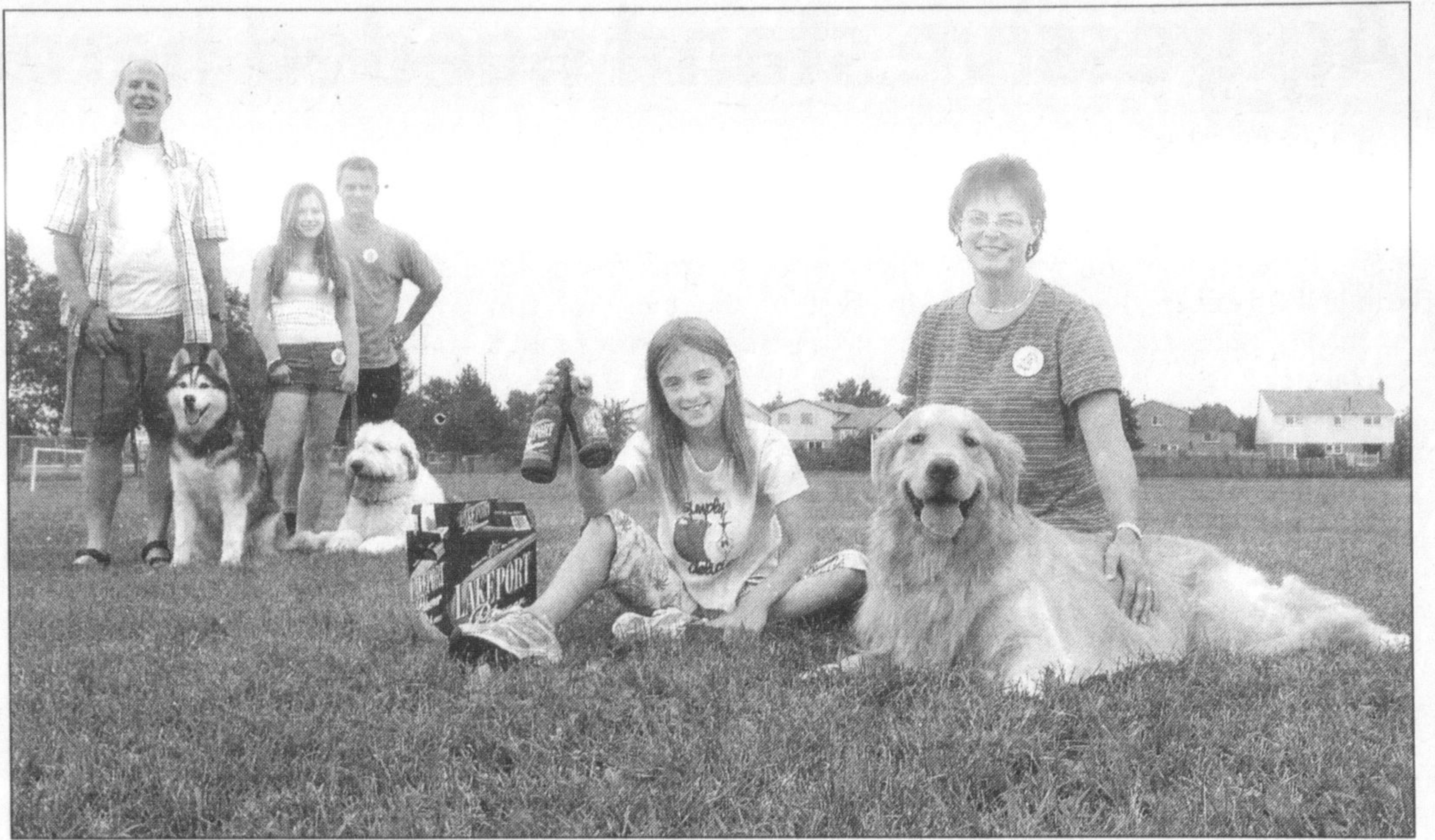

Region program recognized

The Region's School Tour Program has received top grades once again.

This is the second award for the initiative, which received a communications Award of Merit from the Hamilton Chapter of CPRS at its Pinnacle Awards in March.
