Jodi Pejic, Storage Spot's manager of operations, said the facility is also unique in that each storage unit door has its own alarm.

She highlighted the building's state-of-the-art security system that takes a customer's picture as he or she uses a swipe card to enter. Security cameras are also set off by heat and motion sensors.

"We designed the building so women feel safe as well," Pejic said, noting Storage Spot even has 10 intercom stations throughout that'll connect a client with staff. "We want to make sure you and your items are secure."


In addition to storage, the new facility offers a variety of other services, including a FedEx depot, faxing, photocopying and packing supply sales.


That list will grow in the coming months, as Pejic said a small boardroom facility, eBay consignment store and 500 more storage units are going to be brought on board.


