Fletcher wins — again

John Fletcher just can't be kept out of the winner's circle for long.

The OSCAAR Outlaw Super Late Model driver scored his fourth feature victory of the season at Kawartha last Friday night — winning the twin 35-lap main event and bolstering his series points lead in the process.


Coming off back-to-back secondplace finishes, the 38-year-old Miltonian and his JNE Consulting Team didn't exactly start the evening in dominating fashion — securing only the fourth and final berth in their lone qualifying race and starting the first feature in a less-than-promising ninth place.

But with his #61 car in peak condition, Fletcher steadily picked his way

through the field and overtook leader Drew Spicer around the midway marker en route to a relatively comfortable win.

The series points leader was equally impressive in the second feature — moving up to fifth in the first five laps and eventually delivering a convincing win — and finished the night with the 'Power On The Go' hard charger award for passing the most cars.

Looking to take the series championship title after finishing second to London's Rob Clarke the last two years, Fletcher and JNE Consulting begin their final five stretch tomorrow evening at Mosport, where he won his third feature of the year exactly a month ago.
