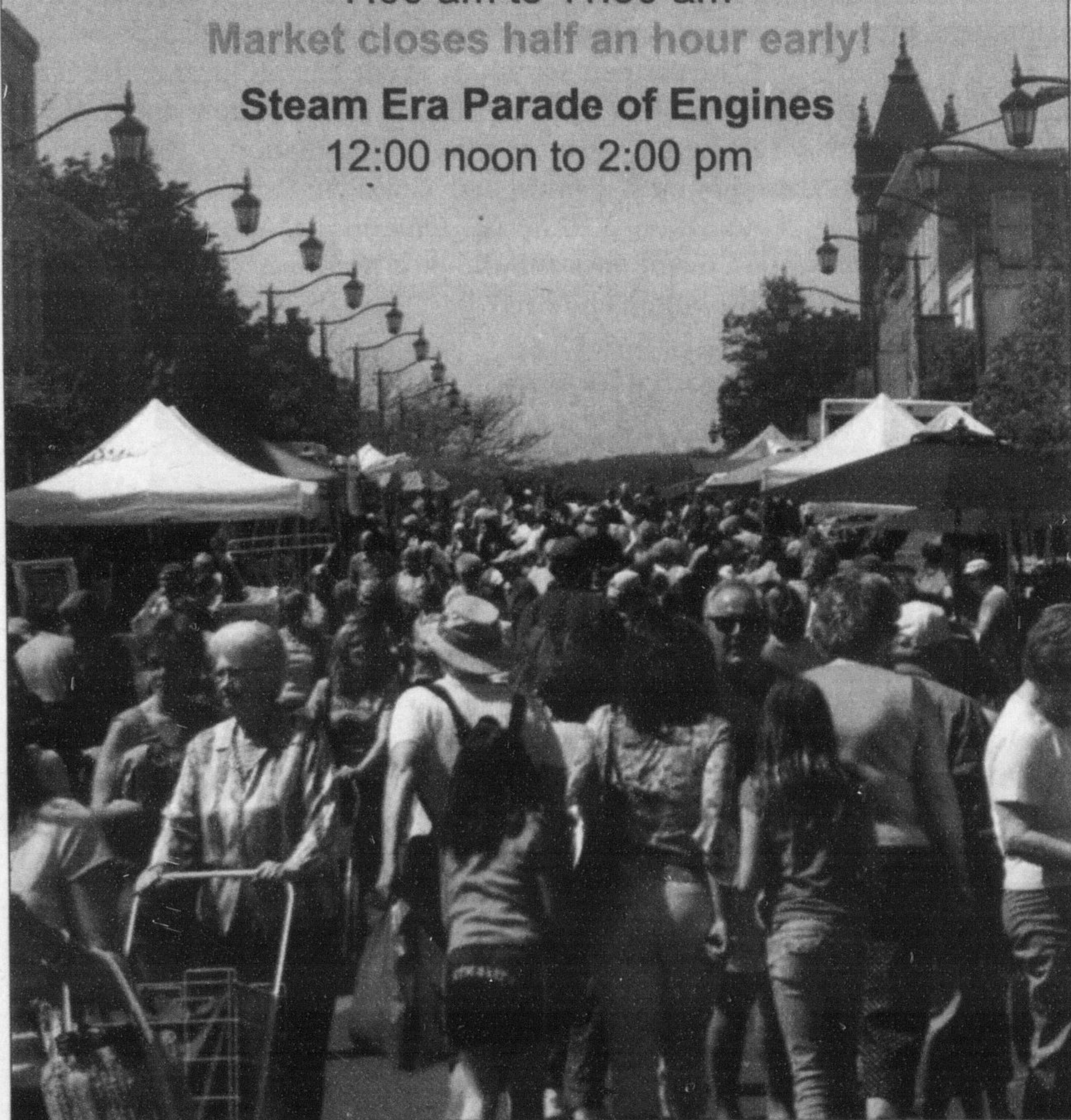

Tate to seek re-election on public school board

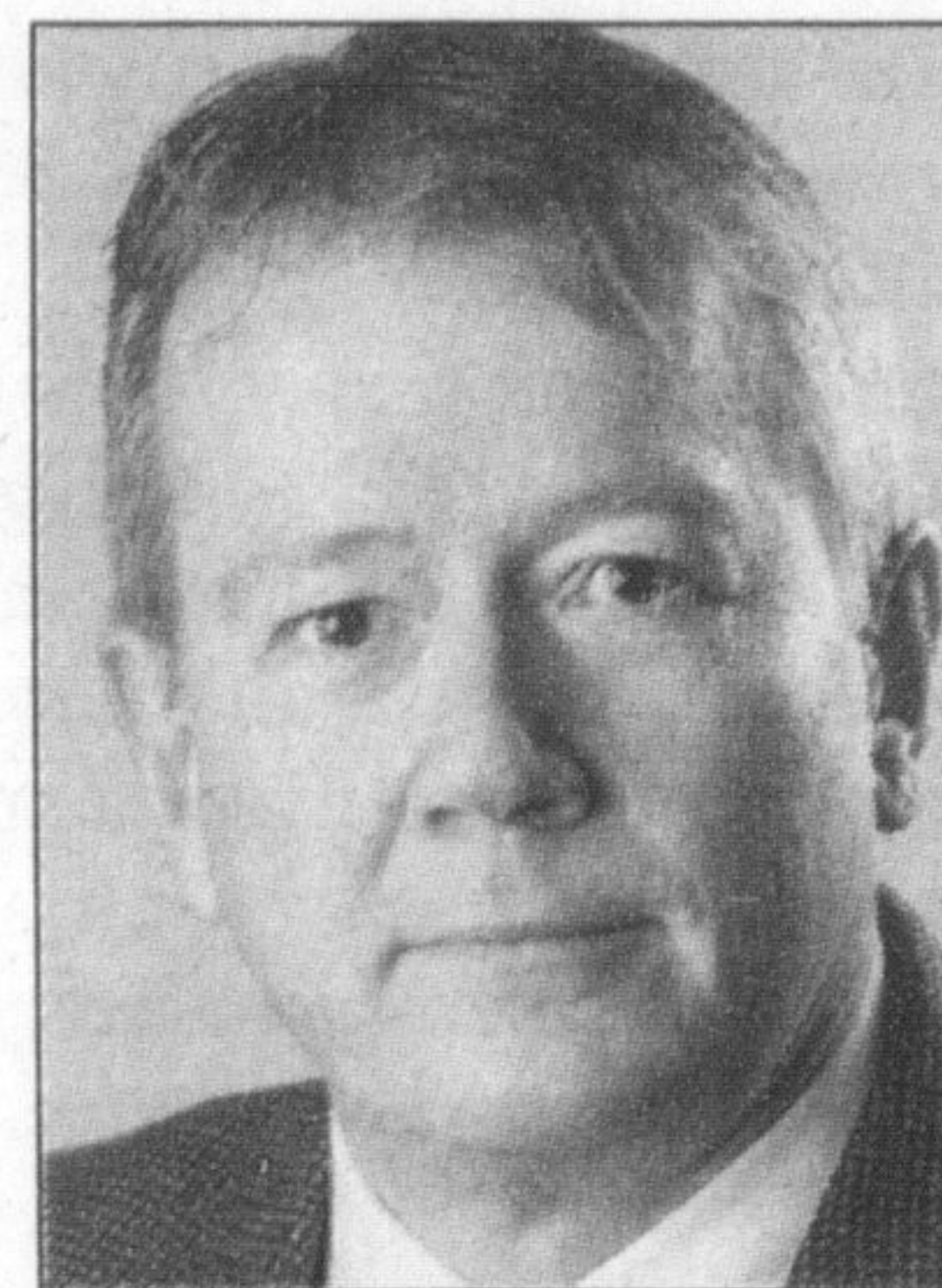
Halton District School Board Chair Paul Tate is seeking a second term as Milton's trustee.

The local resident filed this week to run again in this fall's election and is currently the only person vying for the spot.

Tate served as vice-chair of the board during his first year as trustee and has since been the chair.

He said he feels his chairing the board has helped keep Milton issues at the forefront, since the municipality only has one vote at the table.

"What happens at the school board is critical to

the future performance of Milton and Halton Region," said Tate.

He said that under his leadership the board has accomplished many things, such as convince the Province to fund all of the new schools needed for Milton, improve

financial management to direct more than \$3 million extra to Halton classrooms and introduce controls on senior managers' salaries.

Tate said he also played a strong role in the proposed Halton Regional Campus project to ensure the school board has the opportunity to reduce administrative costs while making it easier for the public to access its services.

He noted he believes "quality education is a child's right."
