Halton's tactical rescue unit earns top marks

Halton's cops are tops. That's according to the provincial government, which has formally recognized that the training efforts of the Halton Regional Police Service's Tactical Rescue Unit meet the highest standards.

Halton Police Chief Gary Crowell reported at a recent Halton Regional Police Services Board meeting that the provincial government has recognized the tactical unit's in-house weekly refresher training.

About two years ago, a project was embarked upon to have the unit's in-house training accredited under the auspices of the Ministry of Community Safety and Correctional Services' adequacy standards.

Graded in 3 areas

Officers carefully documented the course training standards for three mandated areas — hostage rescue, tactical response and perimeter control and containment.

They were recently informed their course training standards and lesson plans were in accordance with the Ministry accredited standards.

"The citizens and police officers in the Halton region are the beneficiaries of this accreditation," said Chief Crowell.

The Halton Regional Police Service is one of only 11 police agencies in the province currently accredited in all three areas of tactical course training standards.

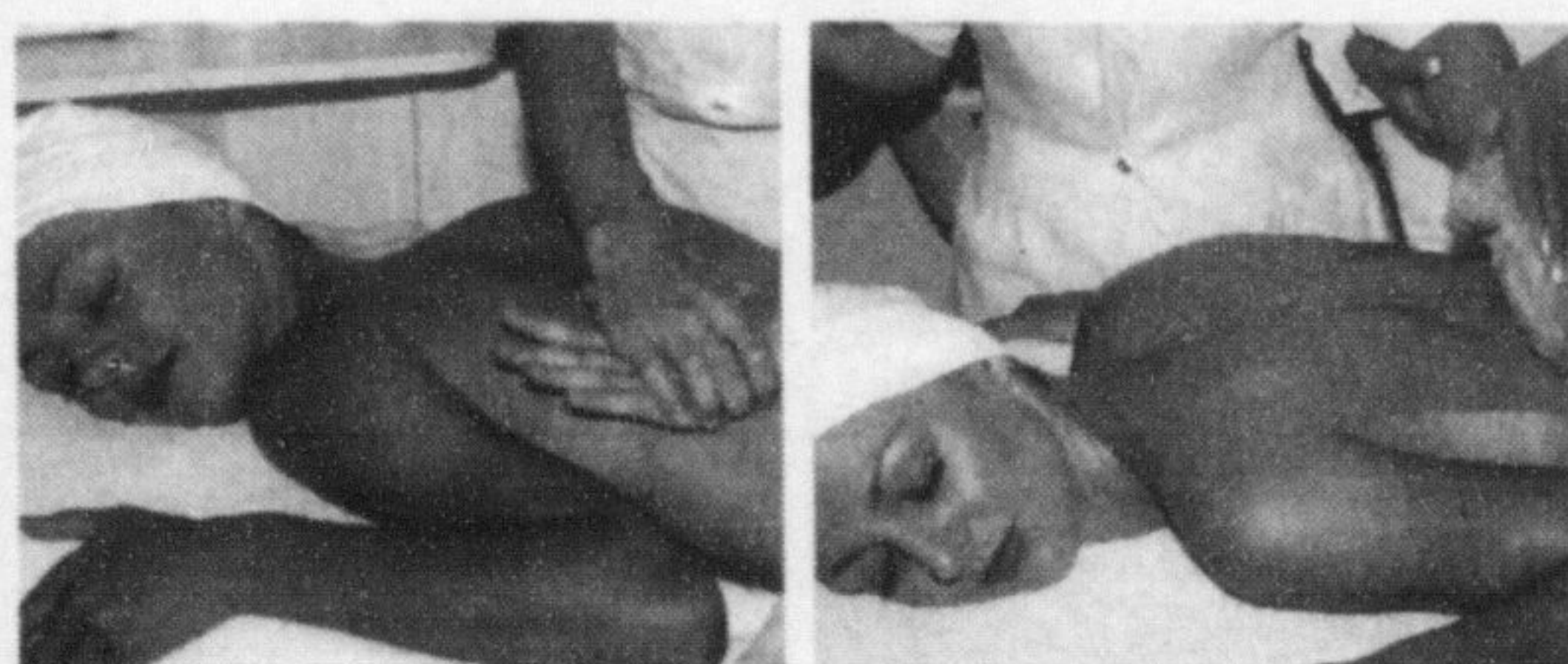
