

House to be rebuilt

"I remember standing up and it was like I was being choked. A couple of seconds after that, I collapsed," he said.

When he regained consciousness, he was in an ambulance, Grant said.

What he didn't know at the time was firefighters had located him thanks to a thermal imaging camera. Without it, chances are he wouldn't have survived, firefighters said at the time.

Fortunately, Grant was the only person home when the blaze broke out. His older brother and sister live elsewhere and his parents were out.

The cause of the fire was found to be a malfunction under the hood of Grant's Jeep, which had been parked in the garage. The fire gutted the garage as well as the second storey.

Although he hasn't suffered any long-term physical effects, Grant said he has been in counseling ever since and is trying to come to grips with what happened.

What's most difficult to deal with are the "what ifs," he explained. "They said the only reason I'm here is because I was in the basement. What if I was on the family room couch and I'd fallen asleep watching TV?"

Returning to school in a couple of weeks will be a welcome refuge and escape from what turned out to be a summer he would like to forget, Grant said.

It'll be at least six more months before the home on White Drive is rebuilt, since it first has to be demolished.
