# Plenty of high stakes action set for Maple Leaf Trot night

The Mohawk race office has assembled a stellar card of races for tomorrow's Maple Leaf Trot night at Mohawk.

Highlighted by the 55th installment of the \$877,500 Maple Leaf Trot - North America's richest event for older trotters - more than \$1.87-million in purses will be up for grabs during the 13-race program, which starts at 7:20 p.m.

A special one-hour edition of Race Night on The Score capped by the Trot - will air live beginning at 9 p.m.

Eight of tomorrow's races are of the stakes variety

The Maple Leaf Trot, has been carded as the seventh race - set to go postward at 9:25 p.m. - and will feature, among others, elimination winners Elegant Man and Sand Vic. They'll leave from posts two and three respectively. Peaceful Way, the lone mare in the field and

the undisputed queen of the elder trotters, finished second in her elimination but lucked out in the draw and will start from the rail.

Making his first start back since lowering the stakes and track record in the August 5 Hambletonian at Meadowlands, Blair Burgesstrained Glidemaster will be part of the second of two \$130,000 divisions of the Simcoe Stakes for three-year-old trotters.

The two divisions have been carded as the first and second races on the night, and Glidemaster has drawn the rail against 2005 O'Brien Award

recipient Was It A Dream and Trond Smedshammer trainee Blue Mac Lad, who hasn't raced since finishing third to in Glidemaster Hambletonian.

Two \$135,000 divisions of the Simcoe Stakes for threeyear-old pacing colts are also on the program — as races three and 10 — and the latter promises to be something to see. Confederation Cup winner Armbro Deuce, Nat Christie victor Armbro Damien and Meadowlands Pace elimination winner Perfect Union will lock up against multi-stakes winning Doonbeg and Mr. Feelgood among others - in the second

Rounding out the night's action will be three \$107,000 divisions of the Champlain Stakes for two-year-old pacers, which are slated as races four,


