

Kitchener gallery presents solo exhibit of local artist

A Kitchener gallery is presenting a solo exhibition of new work by Milton artist Tom Dietrich.

The exhibit, entitled Breaking Ground, will appear at the Homer Watson Gallery, 1754 Mill Rd., until October 29, with an opening reception Sunday from 2 to 4 p.m. with Dietrich in attendance.

In keeping with his trademark themes of environment and connection from his previous work, this exhibit of landscape oil paintings incorporates dynamic sculptural elements, Dietrich said.
