NOTICE OF TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE

THOMPSON ROAD SOUTH FROM MAIN STREET EAST TO CHILDS DRIVE

The Town of Milton, in conjunction with Canadian Pacific Railway and GO Transit, are in the second Phase of the construction of a Grade Separation at the Canadian Pacific Railway crossing on Thompson Road, north of Nipissing Road. The second phase of the project will move the tracks from the current location onto the new bridge and the final alignment.

In order to expedite this work, the following road closure will occur on Thompson Road South from Main Street East to Childs Drive as noted below:

Nipissing Road. Please access Nipissing from Childs Drive.


