Town moving Mary St. home Tuesday

Weather permitting, home will be moved from Mary St. to Bell St. starting at 9 a.m.

Another Mary Street home is being moved to make way for the Town Hall expansion project.

The Town will be relocating the dwelling from 155 Mary St. to 181 Bell St. Tuesday starting at approximately 9 a.m.

The planned route for the move will take the home west along Mary Street, north on Brown Street, west on Main Street, south on Bronte Street and east on Barton Street to Bell Street.

Road closures will take place from 9 to 11 a.m. on Main Street between Brown and Bronte streets and from 9 a.m. to noon on Bronte Street between Main and Barton streets.

In addition, there may be short-term traffic delays along other parts of the route on Tuesday morning.

In the case of inclement weather, the move will be rescheduled for Wednesday.

Prior to the move, some tree branches along the route may need to be trimmed to provide sufficient clearance for the house to travel along the roadways.

The Town-owned dwelling will be sold through a public tender process after the move.

The tender will be posted on the Town's Web site at www.milton.ca and


will also be advertised in local newspapers in the new year.
