

Since taking over this past summer, the IceHawks' new executive has no doubt had some tough decisions to make.

Naming Kilbride native Evan Zych team captain wasn't one of them.

"Evan's a mature young man. He's good at school and with people. He's a leader," said general manager Keith Pandovski, of the 5'11", 180 lbs. defenceman. "He may be young, but he's got the respect of the players in the dressing room, and that's what matters."

While still five months away from his 18th birthday, Zych brings two years of junior experience to the IceHawks — the most recent of which was capped with a Sutherland Cup championship with the Jr. B Cambridge Winterhawks.

So it's not surprising that the OHL Kitchener Rangers' fifth-round pick in 2005 — who was also captain during his bantam year with the neighbouring Burlington Eagles — has been a stabilizing presence for the rebuilding IceHawks.

Remarked Zych, "We've had our struggles, obviously, but hopefully things are starting to turn around. Our lack of experience has been the biggest challenge. Guys need to get their feet wet and learn what this level is all about, and that takes time."

The young captain is not yet sure if he'll be back next season, since some NCAA Division 1 schools have expressed serious interest in signing him. But what he is fairly certain of is that if a strong nucleus of players return for 2007/08 play, the IceHawks should be able to take a sizeable step toward reclaiming their perennial contender status.

"They won't have that adapting period next year. We'll be able to get down to business right away."
