Woman injured, dogs die in First Line motor home blaze

A woman was sent to hospital with burns to her hands after she tried unsuccessfully to save her two pitbulls from her motor home that caught fire early yesterday morning.

Firefighters from all three stations were

called to a property on First Line, near Britannia Road, at about 4 a.m., said Milton Fire Chief Larry Brassard.

Upon arrival, they found a large motor home engulfed in flames. It had begun to

spread to a nearby shed, but firefighters were able to stop it.

The blaze broke out while a 41-year-old woman was sleeping inside. She made it out, but wasn't able to get the dogs out. She suffered third degree burns to her hands and smoke inhalation and was taken to Milton District Hospital.

Damage is estimated at \$10,000. The cause is being investigated.


