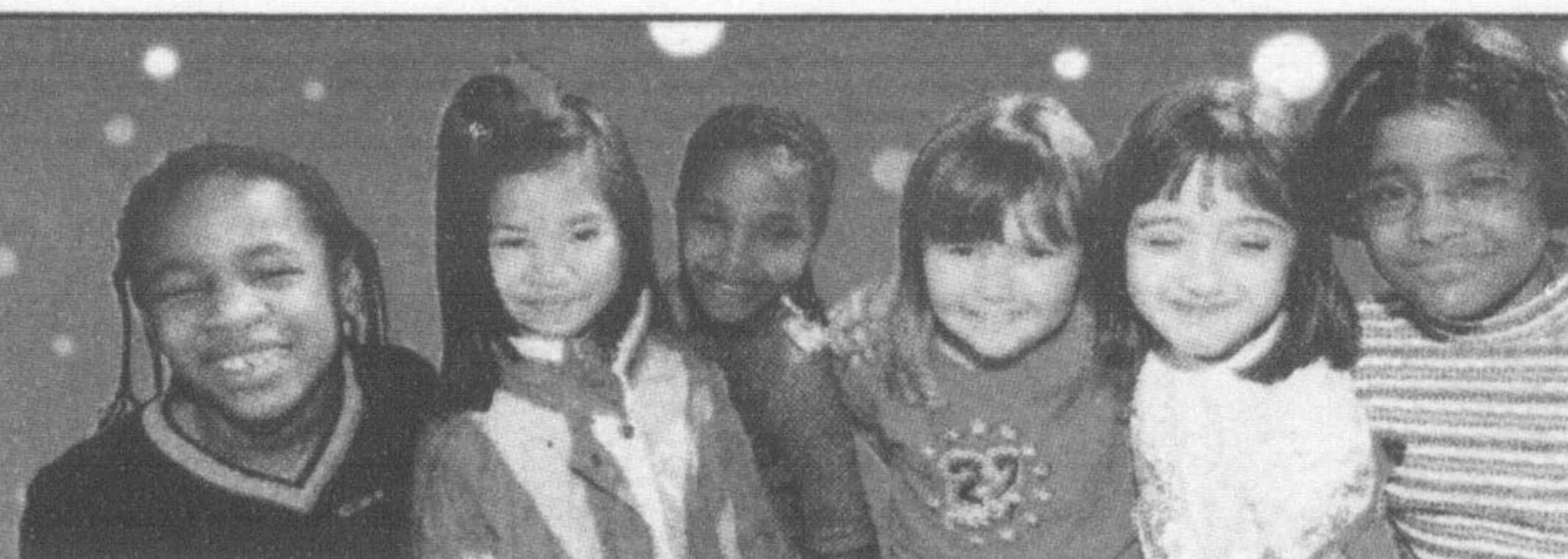


# What Christmas Means to Me
