Councillor Barry Lee suggested using reserve funds to get the tax jump down to 1.23 per cent.

Then, Ward 3 Councillor Cindy Lunau made a motion to stop a one-time transfer of \$400,000 from the slots reserve fund to the legal reserve fund and instead get the money through a one per cent tax increase, thus bringing the total tax increase up to 2.23 per cent.

The budget committee also recommended — and council approved this week - advancing the timeline for the Brookville Park project with \$432,000 from the development charges reserve fund and \$48,000 from the slots reserves and purchasing new library branch computer equipment with \$24,037 from slots reserves.

In addition, council supported removing \$31,000 slated for pesticide bylaw public consultation consultant fees from the budget. The change means the amount of consultation on the topic will be greatly reduced.


