Prohibited weapon, drugs seized from pick-up truck

Police seized drugs and a switchblade after a driver was pulled over for allegedly leaving the scene of an accident.

Just before noon, a Chevrolet pick-up truck was involved in a minor collision with another vehicle in the area of Lawson Road and Nassagaweya/Esquesing Townline. The driver allegedly left the scene after speaking with the other driver.

Marijuana and a switchblade were discovered in the vehicle.

A 23-year-old Havelock man was charged with possession of a prohibited weapon, possession of a controlled substance, failing to remain at the scene of an accident and breach of probation.

Trio breaks into school

Police are carefully studying video footage to ascertain the identities of three suspects in a school break-in December 29.

A security video shows that two males and a female entered Sam Sherratt Public School on Laurier Avenue at about 1 a.m.

They smashed open a window to gain access, went into the office and rummaged through a desk, but nothing was taken. The damage to the building is estimated at \$450.

The two males are described

as having slim builds. One was wearing a mid-thigh-length winter jacket with a fur-lined hood. Underneath it he was wearing a white shirt with an emblem on the front.

The other male wore a similar jacket with a hood and possibly a white toque.

The female has a petit build and was wearing a dark-coloured bomber jacket with a fur-lined hood.
