While most of the world has descended into violence and chaos, Britain maintains order by focusing the people's anger on an arbitrary target: immigrants. Recent refugees and longtime citizens alike are rounded up and herded into ghettos and internment camps while they await deportation. The parallels to both Warsaw and Guantanamo Bay are disturb-

In the midst of this despair, the baby serves as a small reminder of our common humanity. At one point a terrorist radical stops shooting, looks at the baby and says, "I'd forgotten how beautiful they are." The sight of it knocks the wind out of him.

'Children of Men' is so astonishingly detailed that it warrants multiple viewings. I look forward to buying the DVD. I give it four-and-a-half stars out of five.

There are three things wrong with futuristic science-fic-

tion movies.

One is that the vision of the future is always dark and gloomy. Another is that they usually raise more questions than they answer. And thirdly, they try to pretend there's some deep meaning and message hidden in the story.

That fits Children of Men perfectly, which unlike many science-fiction movies doesn't even have the decency to be entertaining. Everybody on the planet, or almost everybody, is infertile? Yawn. Already saw a version of that in the Handmaid's Tale. Anyway, how did it happen? Why is everybody killing each other? Why are people trying to get into a country that wants to kill all immigrants? Why are some trying to get out? Why this? Why that?

The biggest question after a while is: "Who cares?" Movies aren't supposed to be seven hours long, either. At least that's what this one seemed like. It was a snooze fest with a few scattered action sequences. One was particularly helpful, I must admit, because it came at a time when I was nodding off.


