The Milton Fire Department is comprised of 20 full-time and 83 part-time firefighters. It's based out of three stations: central station on Steeles Avenue, station 2 on Reid Sideroad in Campbellville and station 3 on Derry Road.

Since there are typically only four to five full-time firefighters on duty at all times on rotating shifts, the fire department relies a great deal on part-time firefighters.

When an emergency occurs, part-time firefighters are paged. They respond immediately by activating the flashing green lights on their personal vehicles and driving to their designated fire station as quickly and safely as possible.

Milton firefighters will be out at local malls and public areas promoting Green Light Awareness Week throughout the week.
