Members Needed: 2 representatives from human and social service agencies serving Halton

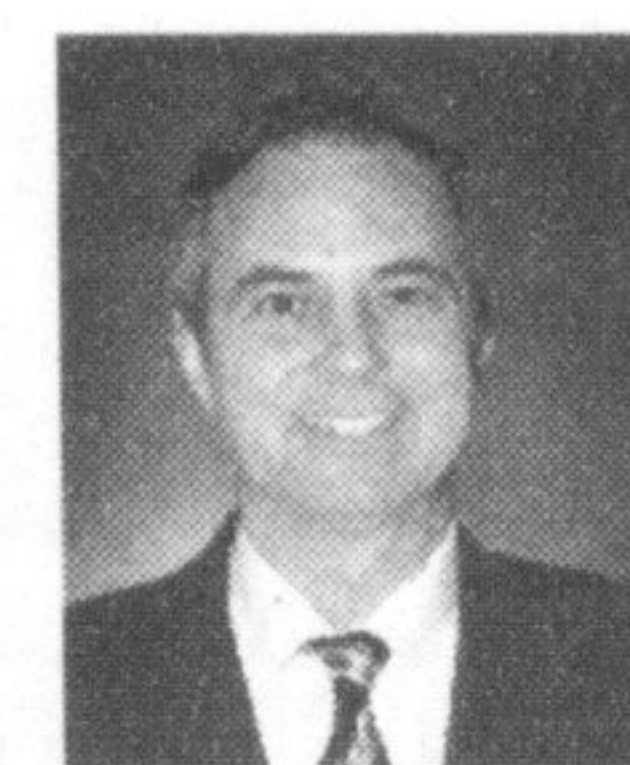
