# Variety store targeted again

Sam's Store on Wilson Drive was broken into last Friday, just two-and-a-half weeks after it was targeted in a violent robbery.

Sometime between 2:15 and 6 a.m., unknown suspects entered the discount store by smashing a rock through the front glass window. Taken were 100 cartons of cigarettes valued at a total of \$3,000.

The store was robbed January 16 by three men including one who pistol-whipped the employee.

## Copper piping stolen

Copper piping valued at \$18,000 was stolen from a construction site overnight January 31.

Police said unknown suspects entered the new school construction zone at Tupper Drive and found the piping inside three large metal storage bins.

## School broken into

St. Peter's Catholic School was broken into last Friday. Unknown suspects entered the Woodward Avenue building just before 3 a.m. The alarm sounded, alerting police and security personnel who responded.

The suspects had entered the school by smashing a window on the southwest corner of the school with a large tree branch. It's not yet known what — if anything — was stolen.

## Snowboards swiped

Three more snowboards were stolen recently from Glen Eden Ski and Snowboard Centre.

Two of the thefts occurred January 31. They were both left unattended, unlocked at the racks outside the main chalet. The first snowboard was stolen at about 3:30 p.m. It was a black, 160 cm Nitro Shogun valued at \$1,050. Then, sometime between 3:45 and 4 p.m., a 148 cm black Simm snowboard was swiped. It was valued at \$300.

The third snowboard was stolen by unknown suspects sometime between January 28 and February 4. It was left unlocked at the same racks. The 153 cm Burton had a black top and grey and white bottom. It was worth \$455.

## Apartment broken into

An Ontario Street apartment was broken into January 26. Sometime between 3:30 and 9 p.m., police said an unknown suspect climbed onto the second-floor balcony and entered the apartment through a bedroom window.

The home was ransacked, with almost \$600 in cash stolen, as well as toys and jewelry. Missing were two silver chains, a bracelet and a gold ring with a blue stone.

The total value of the stolen property is \$1,600.

## Mischief charge laid

A Woodward Avenue resident was awakened recently by the sound of cars being kicked in.

Police said the resident saw a young man walking down the street and kicking vehicles at 4:30 a.m. January 24. While his wife called police, the man followed the suspect.

One vehicle had a dented passenger side door.

A Woodward Avenue man, 24, is charged with mischief under \$5,000 and being intoxicated in a public place.

**Armed robber sought**

Halton Regional Police are investigating a robbery at a local Esso gas station.
