

Equipment stolen, rig set on fire

Construction equipment worth \$30,000 was swiped sometime between last Friday and Monday on Nassagaweya/Esquesing Town Line.

Police said an unknown suspect took welding and drill equipment, including welding torches and pumps, and then set fire to the drill rig.

Man charged in theft

A Waterloo region man has been charged in connection with the theft of sports and snowboarding equipment stolen from a vehicle Saturday.

Snowboards swiped

Between 1:30 and 2:30 p.m., a Burton King gold and green board with Burton bindings was taken. It's worth \$1,000.

And just before 4 p.m., a pair of 165-cm Volrd skis was taken. They have Marker bindings and are valued at \$1,400.

The incident happened just after 1 a.m. Tuesday on Gowland Crescent. Nothing was taken.

Gas station robber sought

Halton Regional Police is looking to the public to help identify the person responsible for robbing a Sunoco gas station in Campbellville.

At 7 p.m. December 2, a man entered the gas bar at 19 Main St. and demanded cash and cigarettes from the clerk. The clerk complied and the suspect fled.

No weapon was seen and the victim was uninjured.

The suspect is described as white, in his mid-to-late twenties and about six-foot-three. He was wearing a black toque and a blue nylon jacket zipped up over his face.
