Paul Wright is the owner and photographer of Shooter4Hire Photography, a new business which recently expanded into Milton. Paul is certainly not what one would expect from your typical photographer. With over 15 years of shooting in and out of the photojournalism field.

He has several different interests, which lends context to his photographic work. Finding time to chat with Paul was quite challenging. Between his trip to Miami and some winter camping, he squeezed in a few minutes to sit and talk over a coffee.

I quickly discovered that Paul is one of those lucky people who manage to combine their personal dreams with their occupation. Paul is passionate about photography and is extremely fortunate that his passion has become his life's work!

As a child, Paul realized his passion for photography early on, at the age of 9. "All I wanted was a camera in my hands. After starting high school and getting involved in my first photography class, I landed a co-op

opportunity at the Burlington Post Newspaper with my mentor Ron Kuzyk". Ron has just won First Place Sports Photography for SNA (Sports Award for North American Wide contest for Community Newspapers.) Ron was a tremendous teacher and gave me the technical know-how to round out my enthusiasm for the profession." Paul was part of a team of photographers for the CFL B.C. Lions. He also shot the Molson Indy, along with the CART auto racing series in Vancouver and Toronto.

The click of the shutter was only the beginning for Paul. He quickly embarked on wedding photojournalism. This is a modern, artful approach, which records the reality of people and their personalities, through a candid and journalism approach. It's not just 'say cheese' at Shooter4Hire Photography. Paul looks for the photos that capture the inside story. "I see the shot already printed. It is a combination of craftsmanship, art and science, creating a painting through the action of light that interprets, motivates and moves."

It's a technical and story telling technique, identifying the theme, raw emotion, the extra edge that makes it a knockout story photo rather than a staged one." His photos will stand the

test of time, and take you back to the day they were first created. Paul also told me that he will go to any lengths to get the shot "lay in the mud if I have to in order to get the shot!"

His photojournalism approach has led Shooter4Hire to produce dynamic, creative imagery for editorial, fashion and advertising. Last year, along with shooting 25 - 30 weddings, Paul also shot the covers for a number of high profile magazines, alongside their leading story. Paul has been called on by many publishing companies. For example CLB Media and Sign Media Canada and Canadian Business Franchise. Shooting covers for Canadian Lawyer, Franchise and GreenMaster, The official publication of the Canadian Golf Superintendents Association. With cover photography for their Superintendent of the Year Award winner, Rhod Trainor, who was the recent host of the Canadian Open. (Incidentally, the award is presented in part with Score magazine.) Are just a few of the titles for which Paul has taken cover photos for. His images have appeared in editorials as well as for commercial purposes as in Oxygen Magazine 2000 with a photo feature on Pilates. Paul also continues to stay on the forefront of the industry in order to provide images that are not only aesthetically creative but

technologically adept as well. He is currently the photographer for the comedy club, Second City Toronto. Paul also traveled across Canada in 2006 as the photographer for "CYBF - Canadian Youth Business Foundation" and the Gala that followed in Toronto where the MCs the Honourable Brian V. Tobin and The Honourable Michael D. Harris. Special guests Sir Tom Shebbaire, Andrew Devenport, Ron Joyce, and many other government and business leaders attended.

Some of his corporate clients include Extreme Pita, Jamaican Appleton Rum and Nygard. Capturing unique and thought provoking moments on film for their product and press releases keeps Shooter4Hire in the corporate eye. He can handle all types of events from small corporate headshots to large Store Opening in Fashion Park's and Company Gala Nights.

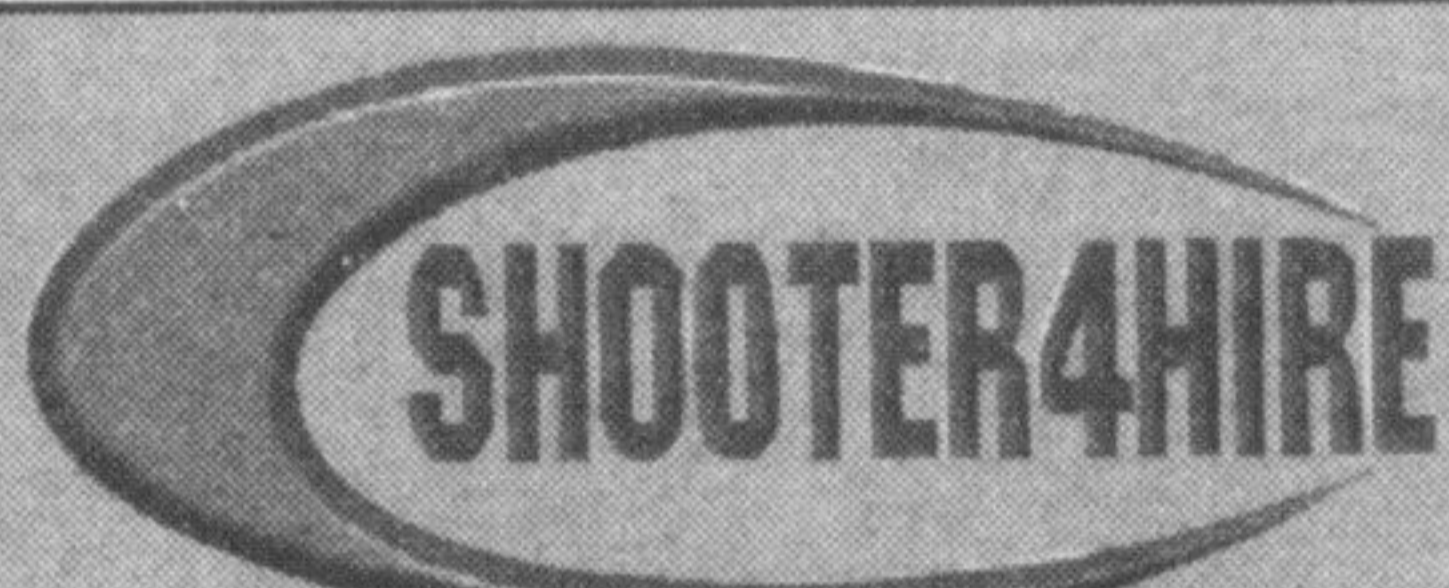


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
