

# Snobelen in court on firearms charges

Milton resident and former Ontario cabinet minister John Snobelen will return to court March 19.

Snobelen, 52, has been charged with careless storage of a firearm, unauthorized possession of a firearm and unlawful

acquisition of a firearm.

The date was set Monday at Ontario Court of Justice in Milton.

The charges stem from a search at a Milton house January 9. Police seized a Colt .22-calibre semi-automatic pistol and

ammunition.

Three days later, Snobelen turned himself in to police and was later released.

Snobelen served as minister of education from 1995 to 1997. He was also a Mississauga MPP.

# Cocaine suspect to return to court Apr. 3

A suspect in Halton's largest ever cocaine bust will return to court in Milton April 3.

Brampton resident Avtar Sandhu, 39, was charged with possession of cocaine for the purpose of trafficking after a truck was pulled over February 4 at James Snow Parkway and Hwy. 401. Police allege more than 200 kilograms of cocaine

was discovered inside.

The cargo had a street value of up to \$20 mil-

The return court date was set February 27 when Sandhu appeared at Ontario Court of Justice in Milton.

Sandhu has been released on bail.
