We have just concluded our 14th Annual Mark's teacher answered, "I was teaching creative writing and familiarizing the students with the story of the ant and the grasshopper. Do you remember it?"

"In fact, one student wrote, 'Mr. Grasshopper, read my lips. No! Absolutely

"But your son ended the story in a different way, in a way that I have never seen in all my years of teaching creative writing. He wrote, 'So, the ant gave all of his food to the grasshopper and the ant died.'

"And at the bottom of the page, Mark drew three crosses. Scribbled under the crosses were the words, 'Jesus died so we could live.' It moved me to tears."

The principle of divine sacrifice was

expressed that day in a way that his teacher had never seen from a 9-year-old. Young Mark knew that Jesus' love for humanity included His willingness to die for each person.


