



health department's 2007 budget by \$50,000 to develop a community-wide air quality modeling initiative that can assess air quality and forecast the impact of new emission sources before they're even built, such as a new factory or highway expansion.

The modeling program will use sophisticated computer models to estimate the concentration of different air pollutants across the community and examine emission sources separately.

In addition to approving funds for the modeling program, regional council endorsed having the Region:

 Examine portable monitoring equipment and/or resources that could be used to assess air quality in micro-environments such as traffic corridors

• Examine the policy instruments that might be used to reduce the reliance on vehicles, in turn reducing emissions of air pollutants and greenhouse gases across Halton

· Develop and implement a health promotion program that educates the public about the link between air quality, human health, climate change and the environment and about actions that can be taken to improve air quality and/or slow down cli-. mate change.

Council also approved — in principle — the commissioning support the development of of stationary air quality moni-'complete communities' that tors, subject to a report back from staff on May 24.

The contest is open to all teachers from preschool to grade 12 in the public and Catholic school systems, as well as Milton's private schools.


In addition to a feature on the winning teacher in the Champion, his or her class will receive a pizza party.


