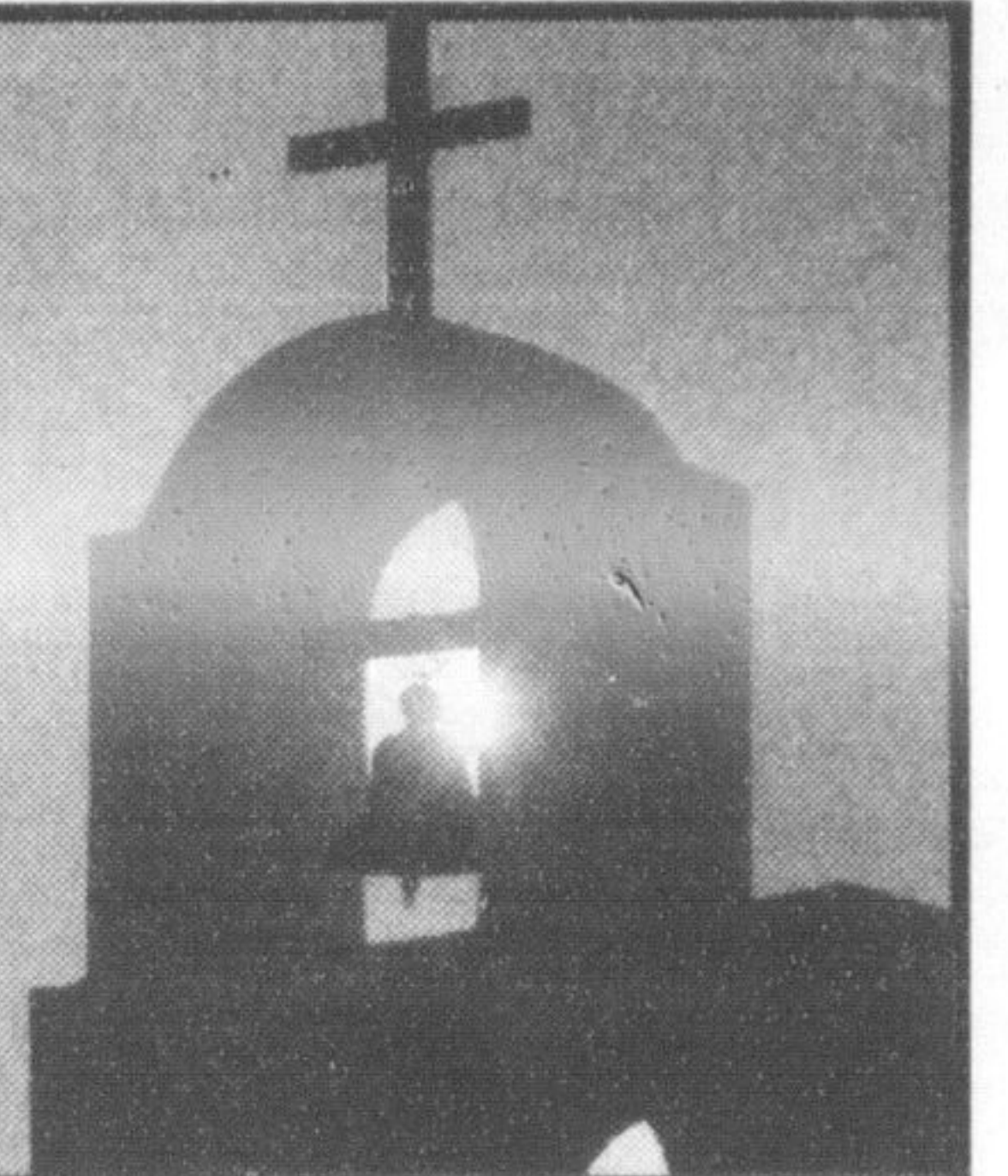


Your Invitation To Worship
