Tykes drop Tri County opener


Milton's tykes had victory in the palm of their hand, but just couldn't maintain their grip.

However, holding the favoured Highlanders at bay would eventually prove to be too much for the visitors, with three goals against — including a last-minute insurance tally — nixing their upset bid.

The Winterhawks host game two tonight at Milton Sports Centre (MSC). Game time is 6:30 p.m. The series returns to Fergus tomorrow afternoon, and if necessary game four will be played at MSC Monday at 6:30 p.m.







