

Swimming and Ear Infections.

Since the better weather is upon us, children often tend to spend more time swimming or taking lessons. Children with a history of ear infections often require ventilation tubes which are surgically inserted in their ears and in order to ensure that water does not pass through the ear tubes it is often recommended that ear plugs be worn.

Although many styles and types are available, custom swim plugs are considered to be the most effective at preventing water from entering the ears. For older children, who swim under water for extended periods of time, an aqua-band (water headband) can be used to cover the ear plugs to keep them in place and add extra protection.


