
From there Bucks sniper Leo Thomas scored his first of two goals just 24 seconds later, and Laredo cruised to a rather deci-

"Ryan's a big guy, and having played at the elite level he's very focused," noted Turner.



The Red Sox get 2007 underway Sunday at Brian Best Park against Brampton at 1 p.m.




