

Reding advances to GHAC final

Locked in a scoreless stalemate after two innings of play with M.M. Robinson Wednesday afternoon at Burlington's Nelson Stadium, Joe Jurus offered a simple and straightforward challenge to his Bishop Reding Royals.

"This game is ripe for the

taking, and it's for the taking right now," stressed the seasoned manager.

The Royals apparently took that notion to heart, scoring twice on four hits in their next at-bat on the way to a 4-1 victory and advancement to yesterday's GHAC qualifying final.

Leading offensively were Will Hunter and Lee Mathé, who drove in two runs and scored on a perfectly-played steal of home in the fifth.

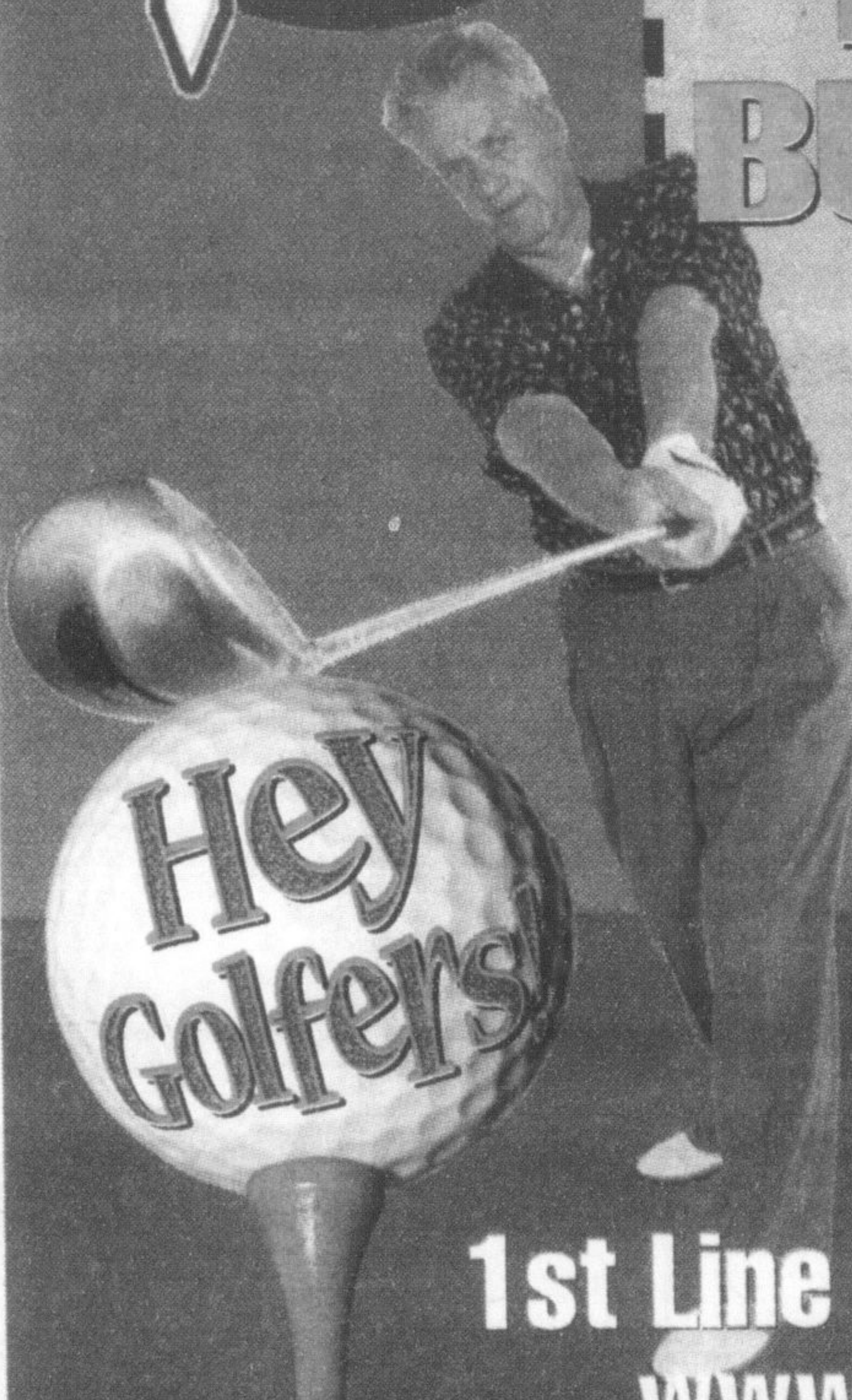

NOTICE OF PESTICIDE USE

The Halton Region Health Department monitors standing water and catch basins for mosquito larvae each West Nile virus season. The surveillance is limited to those in urban areas that are on public lands in Burlington, Halton Hills, Milton, and Oakville. When mosquito larvae are found, the Health Department uses larvicide to control the larvae in order to reduce the incidence of West Nile virus in Halton. Larvicide will be applied by a licensed applicator contracted by the Region.

In Standing Water

Throughout the summer, larvicide will be applied to standing water sites under the direction of the Medical Officer of Health, Dr. Bob Nosal. A granular formulation of the larvicide Bti (Bacillus thuringiensis israelensis), Aquabac™ 200G, registration number 26863, will be placed in affected standing water in urban areas on public lands in Burlington, Halton Hills, Milton, and Oakville. Signs will be posted at each location indicating when the larvicide was applied.

In Catch Basins

Throughout the summer and through to October 31, 2007, larvicide will be applied to catch basins under the direction of the Medical Officer of Health, Dr. Bob Nosal. A pellet and/or briquet formulation of the larvicide methoprene (Altocid®), registration number 21809 for pellet formulation, 27694 for briquet formulation, will be placed in catch basins in urban areas on public lands in Burlington, Halton Hills, Milton, and Oakville.
