Learn how to transform used pieces of paper

Looking to try something a little different to get your creative juices flowing?

The Fine Arts Society of Milton (FASM) is holding an upcoming workshop on paper-making that's open to both members and non-members.

The Art of Papermaking — a Building Block for Mixed Media will take place Saturday, May 26 from 9:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. at Grace Anglican Church, 317 Main St. E., with instructor Sandra Spagnuolo.

The cost is \$45 for FASM members and \$55 for non-members.

All supplies will be provided, but participants can bring along any plant-based materials they'd like to include, such as fresh or dried flowers, vegetable peelings, leaves, etc. Or they can bring along a watercolour painting that didn't work out.

Participants should bring a lunch.

Workshop-goers will learn to transform old papers into one-of-a-kind textured sheets by combining the old papers with fibres and plant materials.

By the end of the class, participants will have made a small greeting card with hand-

made paper.

Spagnuolo is a local mixed media artist with a passion for paper and textiles. Before bringing her art to canvas, she enjoyed 12 years of making greeting cards, journals and boxes with her handmade papers.

Registration and payment must be made five days before the workshop.

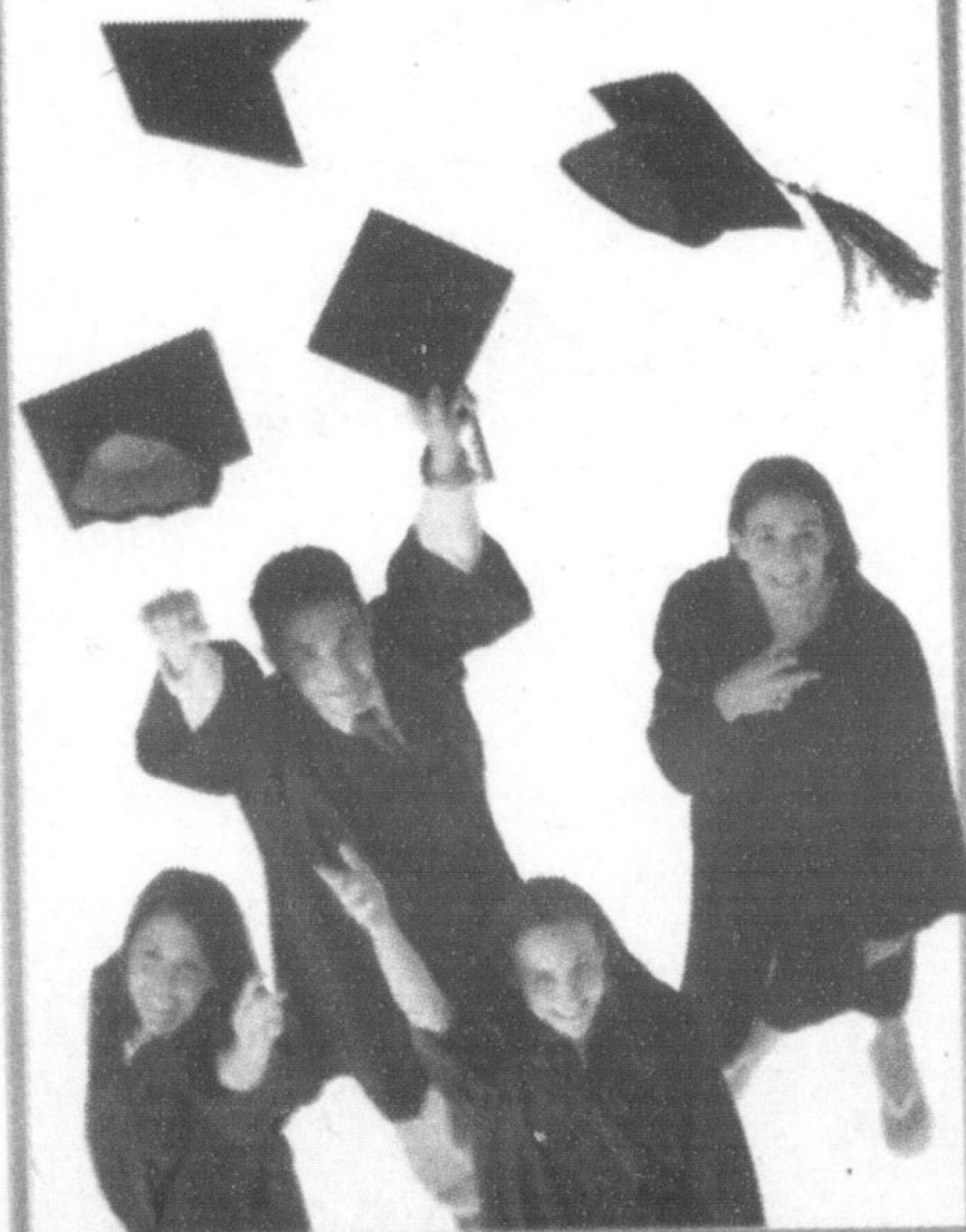

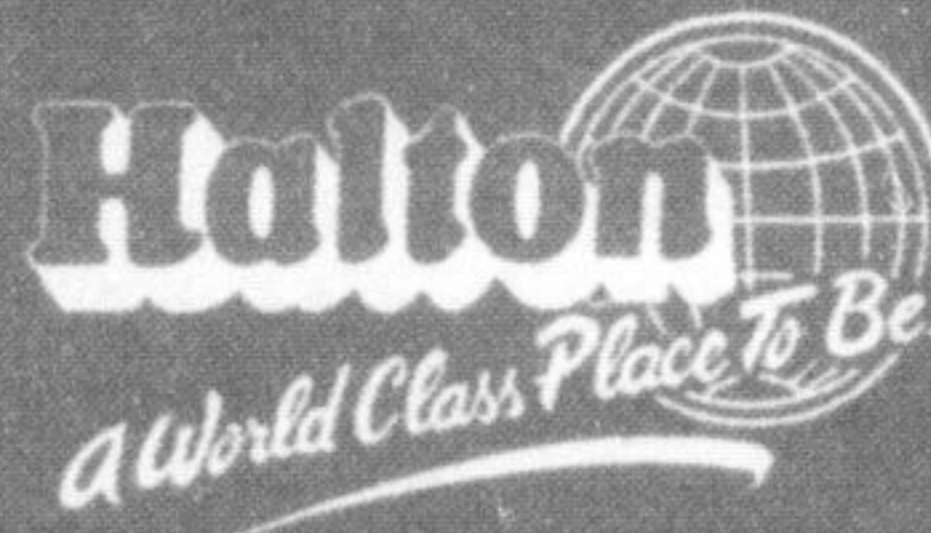
