Kicking things off will be rock band Sokey, followed by Dead Celebrity and Hexus.

The doors open at 8 p.m. and admission is \$5.

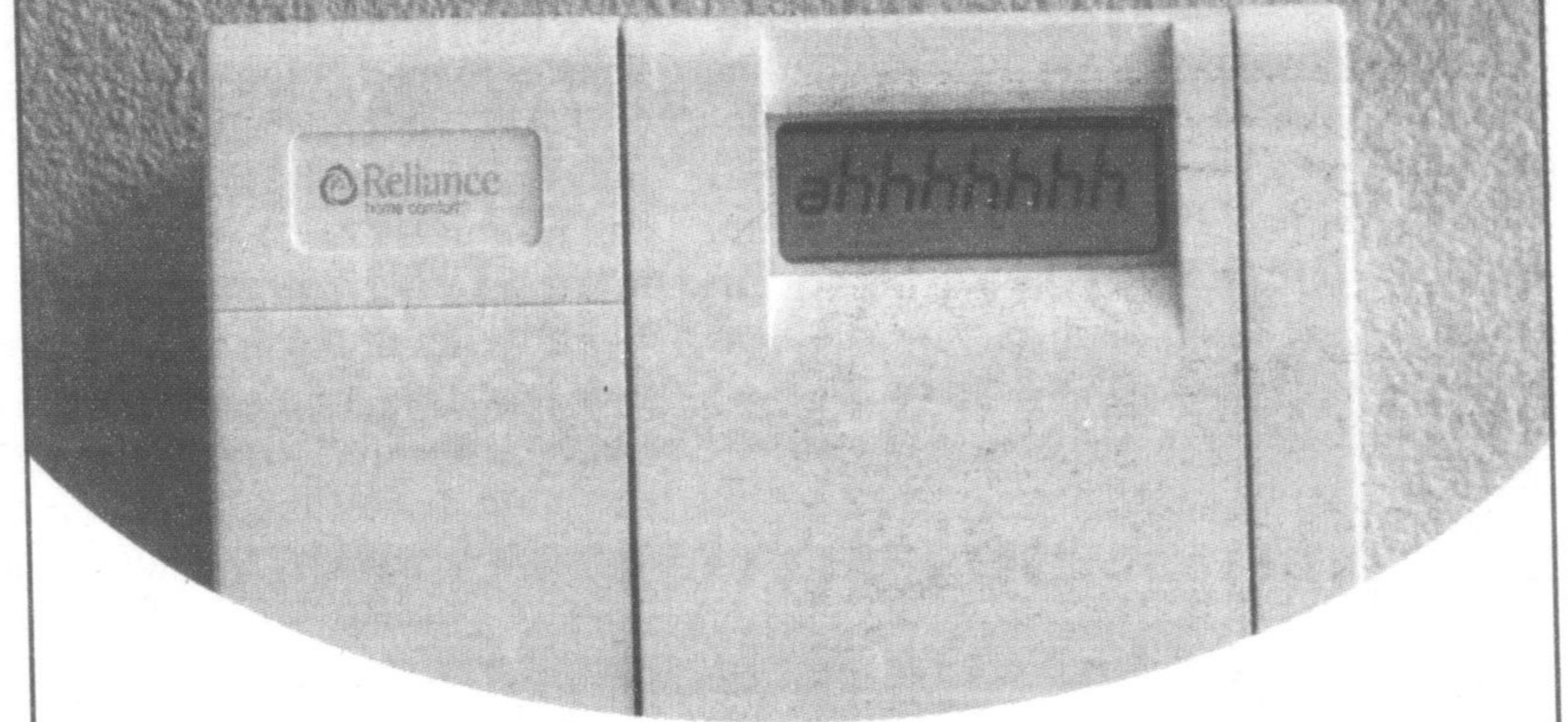
Slated to begin at 3:30 p.m., the show — put
