

Drinking Water Source Protection Committee Expressions of interest for the position of Chair

Lake Erie Source Protection Region

The Ontario government passed the Clean Water Act, 2006 to help protect drinking water at the source. It calls for the development of Drinking Water Source Protection Plans in a process guided by a Source Protection Committee made up of representatives of municipalities, agriculture, business, industry, landowners, First Nations and others.

In anticipation of the proclamation of the Clean Water Act and the making of regulations providing for the establishment of Source Protection Committees, the Grand River Conservation Authority is compiling a list of persons who would be interested in serving as Chair of a Source Protection Committee for the proposed Lake Erie Source Protection Region, should the Act and anticipated regulations come into force.

The Chair would be appointed by the Minister of the Environment.

The duties of the Chair include:

- · chairing meetings and guiding the effective operation of the committee
- · working collaboratively with stakeholder groups and other organizations
- reporting on the progress of the work to the four Source Protection Authorities

The qualifications of the Chair include:

- willingness to remain neutral
- · advanced negotiating, mediation and facilitation or consensus-building skills
- · familiarity with rules of operation of committees
- understanding of municipal and conservation authority functions and processes
- knowledge of Lake Erie Region Source Protection region watersheds, communities and issues
- willingness to make a commitment of five years




