## DonorInformation

- If you are between the ages of 17 50 and are in good health, you can be a donor.
- Bone marrow type is not determined by your blood groups.

- · Following an information session two vials of blood are drawn one vial is tested for HLA-typing, the other vial is tested for the last two antigen matches by DR/DNA typing.
- If you are a match, 6% of your bone marrow is collected from the hip under general anesthetic: the bone marrow taken is replenished in a few


