Joins Novak, Kalapaca behind bench

Longtime local hockey fans will see another familiar face behind the IceHawks' bench this fall besides Randy Novak and Mike Kalapaca.

The returning head coach and assistant will be joined by native Miltonian Mike Rusk — who recently moved back to

the area after spending much of the past decade patrolling the blueline in the professional ranks, including two games with the AHL's St. John's Maple Leafs.

A 1993 ninth round pick of the Chicago Blackhawks, the 32-year-old — a former teammate of Todd Bertuzzi and Jeff O'Neill during his OHL days with the Guelph Storm — has been coaching minor hockey in Dallas for the past few years.

"Mike can relate to the players," said Novak, who's known Rusk for most of his life and followed his career closely since his time in the Mississauga rep system. "He'll work closely with them to improve their individual skills and will play good cop at times when Mike (Kalapaca) and I will be the bad cops."

Novak said he's been quite impressed thus far with new owners Dean Piett and Rob DeVincentis, who contrary to initial speculation seem poised to make a real financial commitment to the club.

Case in point is the allocation of extra ice time for summer skates, as well as recently sending their bench boss to the recent Performance 2 coaching seminar at York University.

"These guys have been very professional. They know what they're doing and I'm really pleased with how things are going," added Novak, who's expected to have a few player signings finalized this weekend.

The IceHawks' main camp begins in mid-August.
