As the vehicles departed from the scene, the victim noticed there were two black males in the suspect's car.

Fortunately, the victim wasn't injured.

Acting Det. Sgt. Duncan Taylor said the victim did the right thing in handing over the car without any argument.

"Never put your own safety in jeopardy for property," he said.

Police are asking the public to keep their eyes open for both the victim's and the suspect's vehicles and to call 911 if they're spotted.

Residents are being warned not to approach the vehicles or their occupants.

The victim's car is a black, four-door, 2007 Toyota Camry with the licence plate APWW315. It has a stock stone deflector on the hood.

The suspect's vehicle is a grey, four-door, 2007 Toyota Camry. It has a seven-digit licence plate with A and Z as the first and third letters respectively.

The suspect is described as a black male, about 18 to 20 years old and six feet tall with short curly hair. He was wearing a navy blue hooded sweatshirt.




