## Fatal car crash case back in court | Mail delivery another concern

A young Milton man charged with drunk driving in a collision that claimed the life of an Orangeville man will return to court early next week.

Alvaro Diaz, 21, has been charged with impaired driving causing death, dangerous driving causing death, having over the legal limit of alcohol in his blood, driving with alcohol above zero with a G2 licence and using unauthorized licence plates.

Diaz will make his next appearance Monday at Ontario Court of Justice in Milton on Steeles Avenue.

The return court date was set July 3 in the Milton courthouse.

The horrific two-vehicle collision took place February 2 on Regional Road 25, south of No. 5 Sideroad, killing a 48-year-old motorist just before 3 a.m.

In speaking with the Champion after the meeting, Fire Chief Larry Brassard said he's happy that the public process is making residents more aware of the emergency service sector's needs.


