> The boy was treated at Milton District Hospital, and as with any dog bite in which the skin is broken, the Halton Region Health Department was notified.

The McGibbons have been told that unless the dog's information is provided this week, Daniel will have to get the rabies shots.

"We're not trying to cause any trouble, we just need the dog's vaccination records," noted Jason, who said a woman was walking the two dogs, the one in question apparently named Maxmilian.

"Obviously we're pretty nervous about the idea of Daniel having to get these shots."
