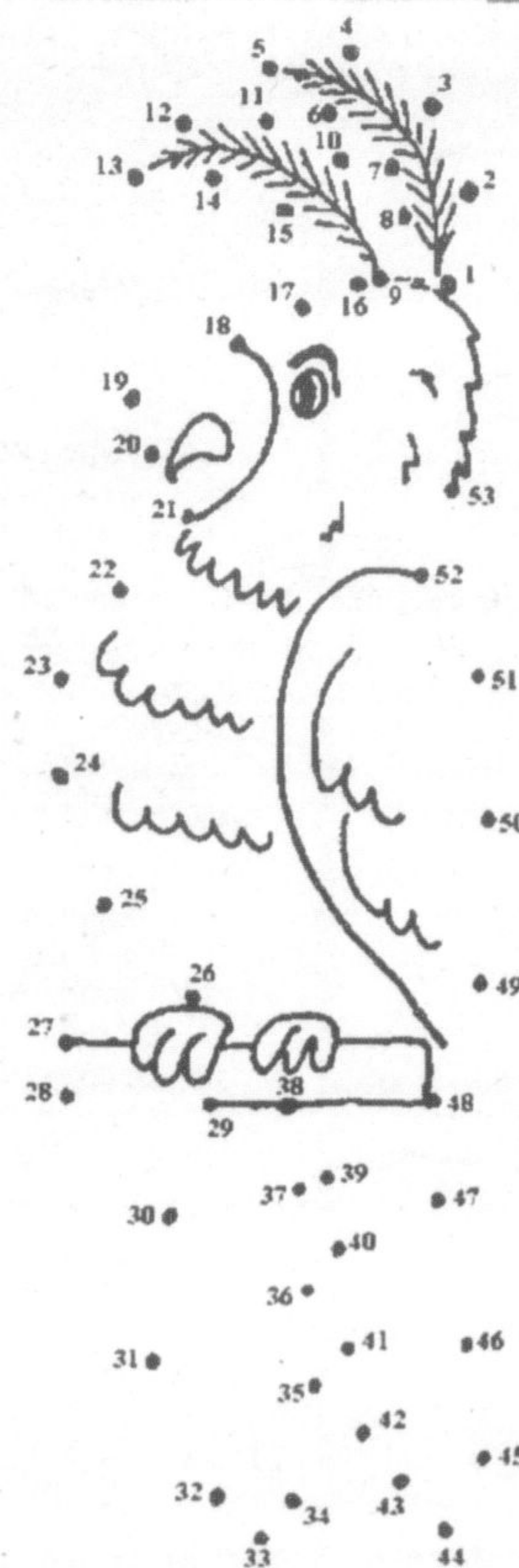
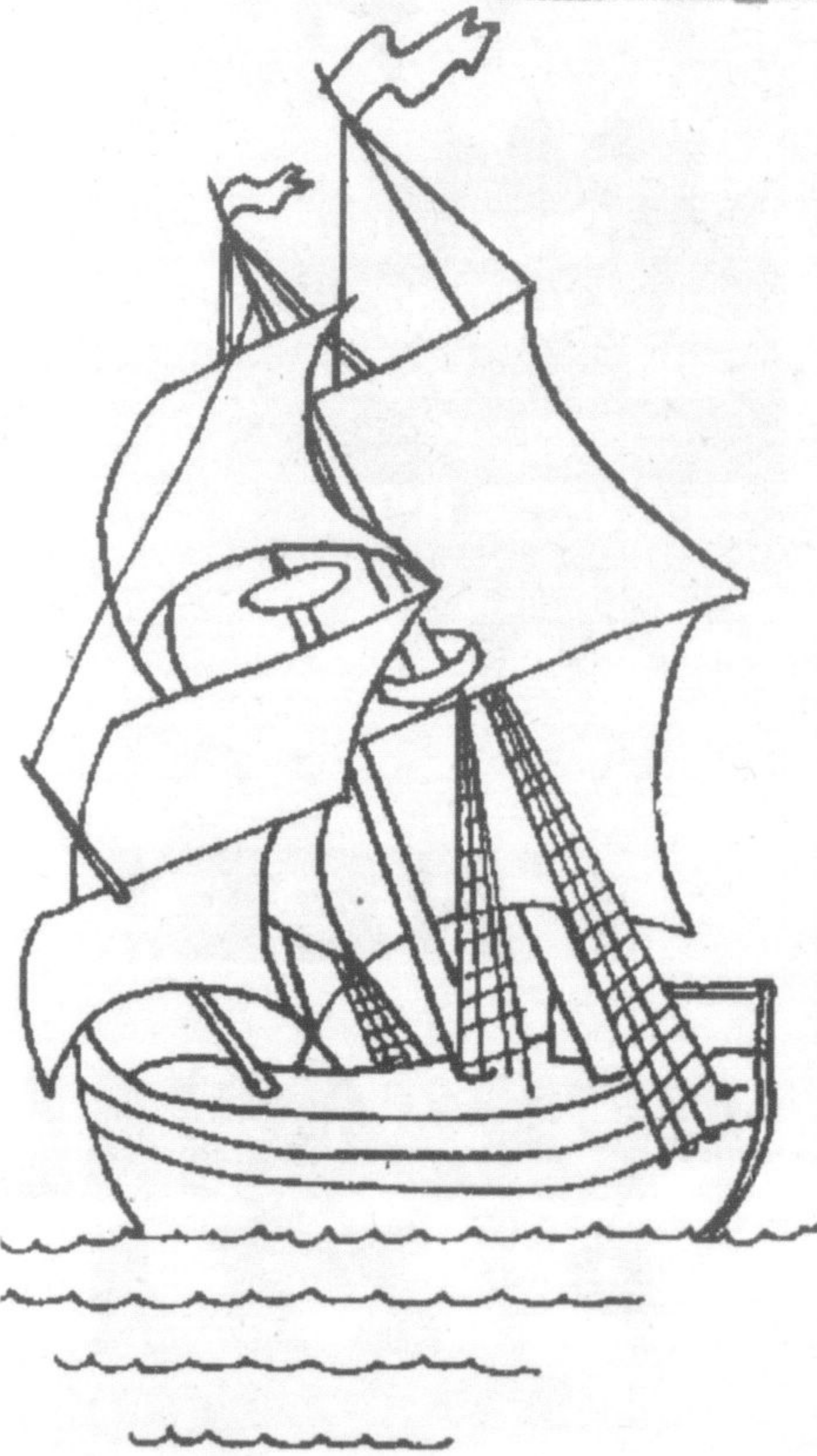

Get up close and personal with bats

Did you know that bats can save the rainforest? That crops such as bananas, avocados, vanilla and peaches rely on bats for pollination?

For an animal that has such an important role to play, bats sure do get a bad rap.

The Mountsberg Wildlife Centre is offering the public a chance to get up close and personal with bats at its annual Bat Night this coming Saturday from 7 to 9 p.m.

Visitors will be able to watch as dozens of bats drop from their daytime roost to begin their nightly hunting for insects. This family event also includes a puppet show, storytelling and games.

The program is one of the Nature Discovery Series events offered throughout the year at Mountsberg. The cost is \$12 for adults and \$10 for kids aged 12 and under. To register, call (905) 854-2276. Advance registration is required.

Farm fun for kids at Country Heritage Park

Kids and parents alike are invited to escape the hustle and bustle of daily life and spend a day in the country.

Country Heritage Park presents 'Kids Country' from this Saturday to Monday with farm fun for kids of all ages running from noon to 5 p.m.

The animal train is always a highlight, whether kids prefer to lead on the horse or trail behind as the pig.

Other activities include sawhorse animals, pedal tricycles, beanbag pitching, tractor-drawn wagon rides and pedal harness horses.

The park's two new welsh ponies, Gumdrop and Lollipop, will be available for pony rides, and Dodge and Legacy, the resident miniature horses, will be on display.

"(This event) promises to be both fun and educational for all children," said a spokesperson at the park.

Admission costs \$7 for adults, \$6 for seniors, \$4 for kids aged six to 12 and free for younger children. A family pass is also available for \$20.

The heritage homes will be open all weekend for kids to explore and learn what life was like when grandma and grandpa were kids.

Featured exhibits include the Cassin family farmstead, which portrays life in the 1830s; the interactive dairy display, which demonstrates the development of milk, cheese and butter in Ontario; the one-room Nassagaweya School, in which visitors can experience school life of the early 1900s; and the 1870s Lucas house, which is said to be haunted.
