British cars from the pre-war era to present day will be showcased this weekend on the scenic Halton Region Museum grounds in Kelso Conservation Area.

The display, hosted by the British Saloon Car Club of Canada, will run from 11 a.m. to 4 p.m. on Sunday.

The club has a wide variety of vehicles including Wolseleys, Rileys, Hillmans, Austins, Rovers and Morrises. These cars are all considered saloons — a British term for sedan.

The British Saloon Car Club of Canada, established in 1994, boasts roughly 540 members worldwide who are passionate about the lesser-known British cars. Each year the club hosts its

display for the general public on the grounds of the Halton Region Museum, with a picnic for members in the historic Alexander Barn.

Entry to the car display is free with admission to Kelso Conservation Area. Tours of the Halton Region Museum are also available to the public at no additional charge.

For those wishing to make a full day of their visit, the park features other recreational activities including fishing, boating and swimming in Kelso Lake, along with hiking and biking on Niagara Escarpment trails.

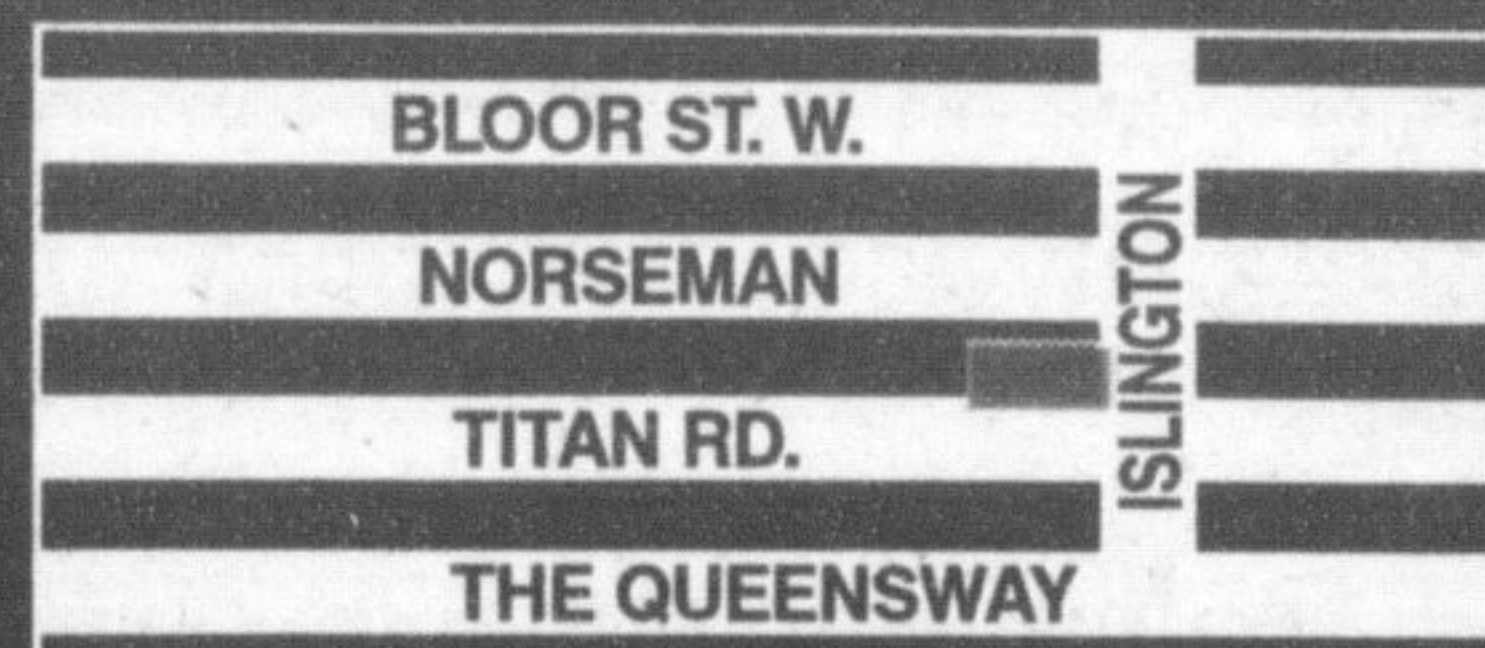
