Company giving community fundraising challenge

The Futures for Kids \$200,000 endowment fund is being created through the EnGlobe matching challenge.

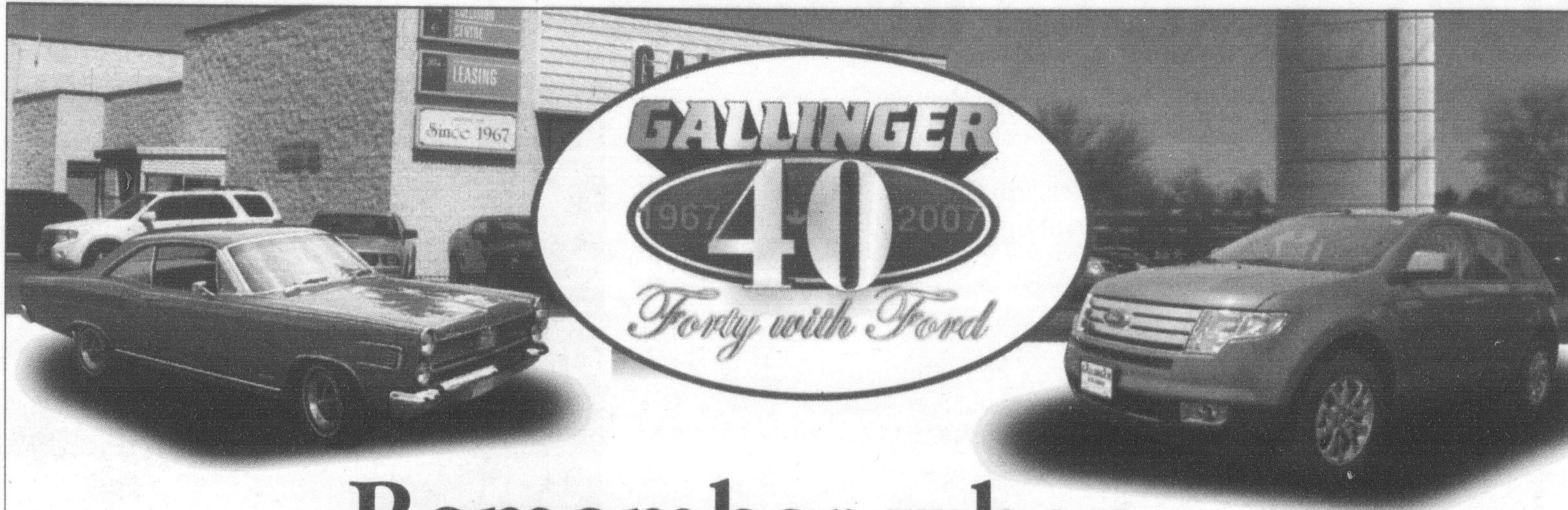
The fund will be managed by an experienced team at the Community Foundation of Oakville, which will ensure a flow of regular income from astute investments in support of BBBSH programs.

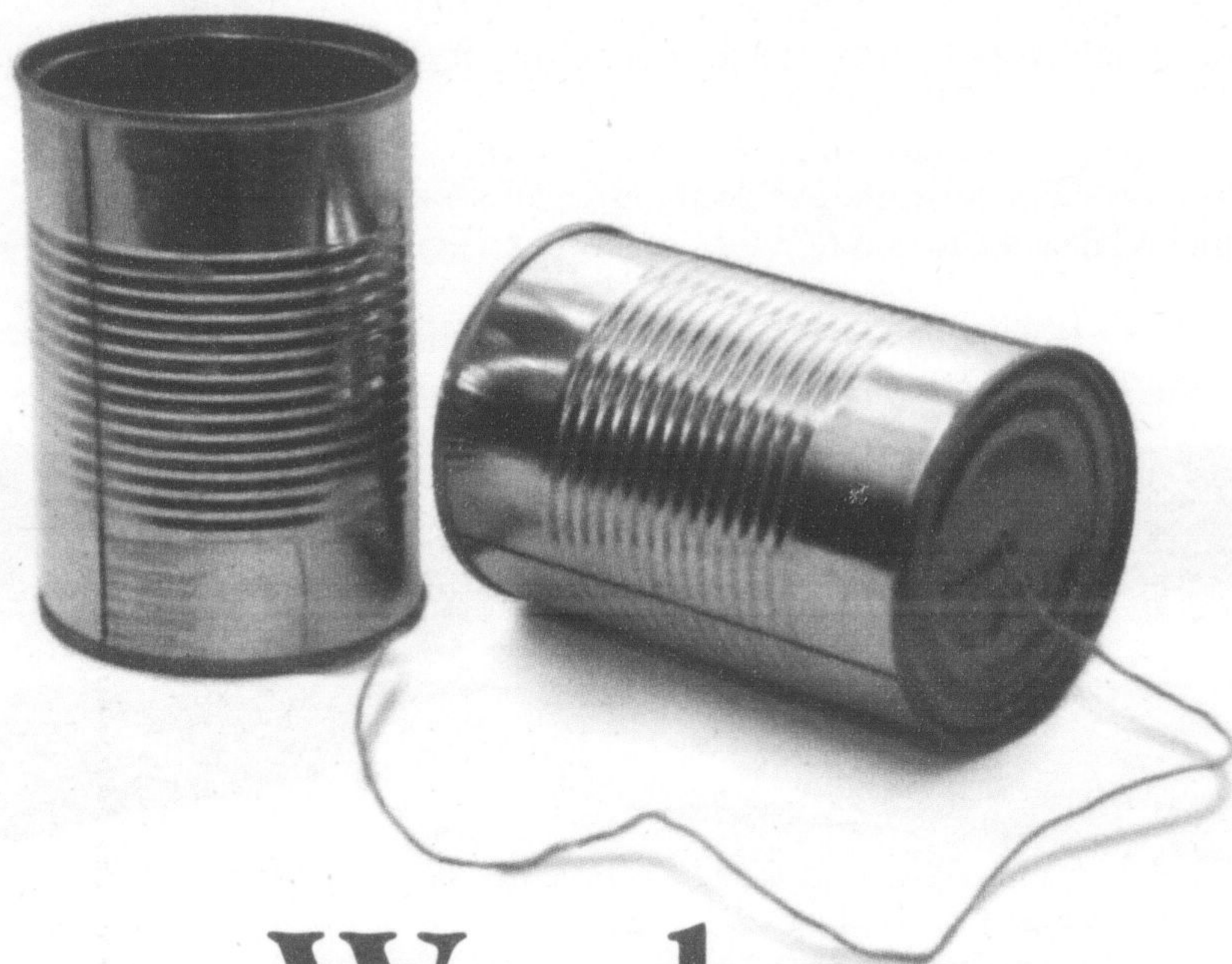
EnGlobe CEO and Oakville resident Tony Busseri said the matching challenge is part of the company's desire to play an active role in the community.

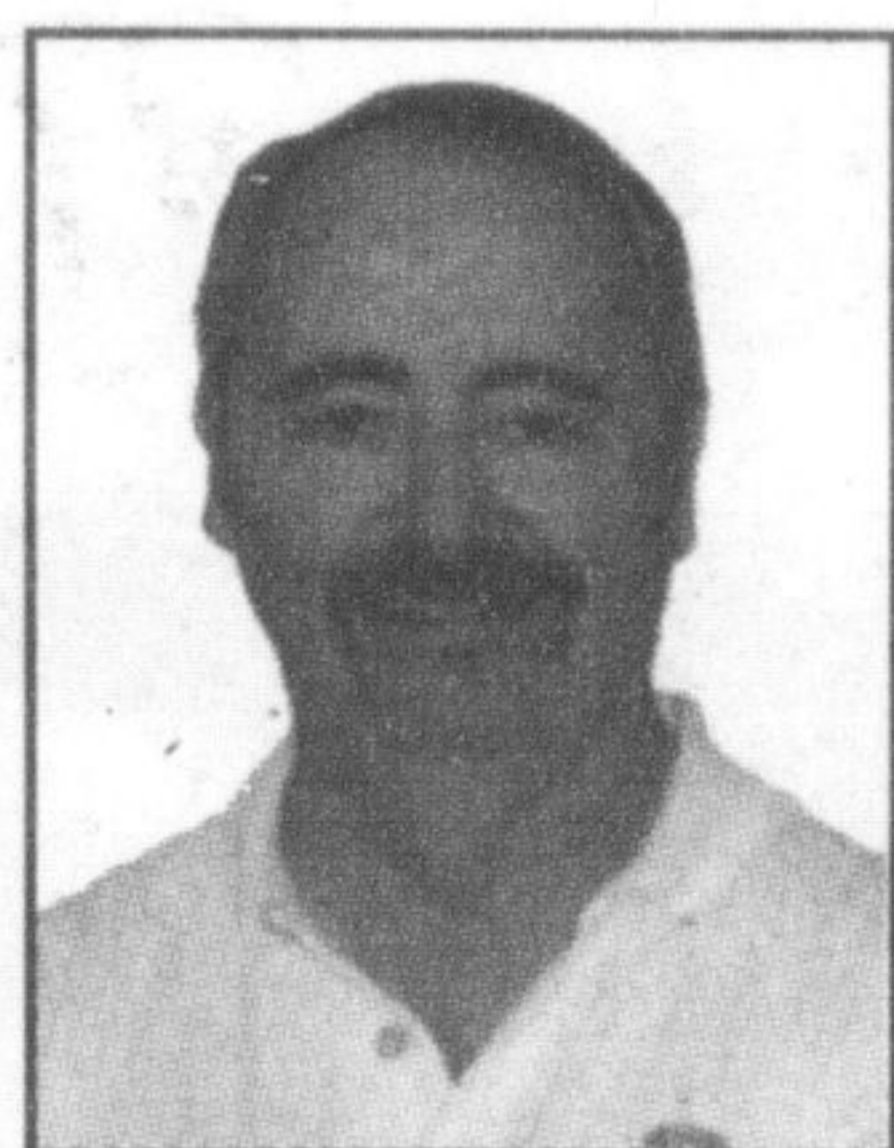

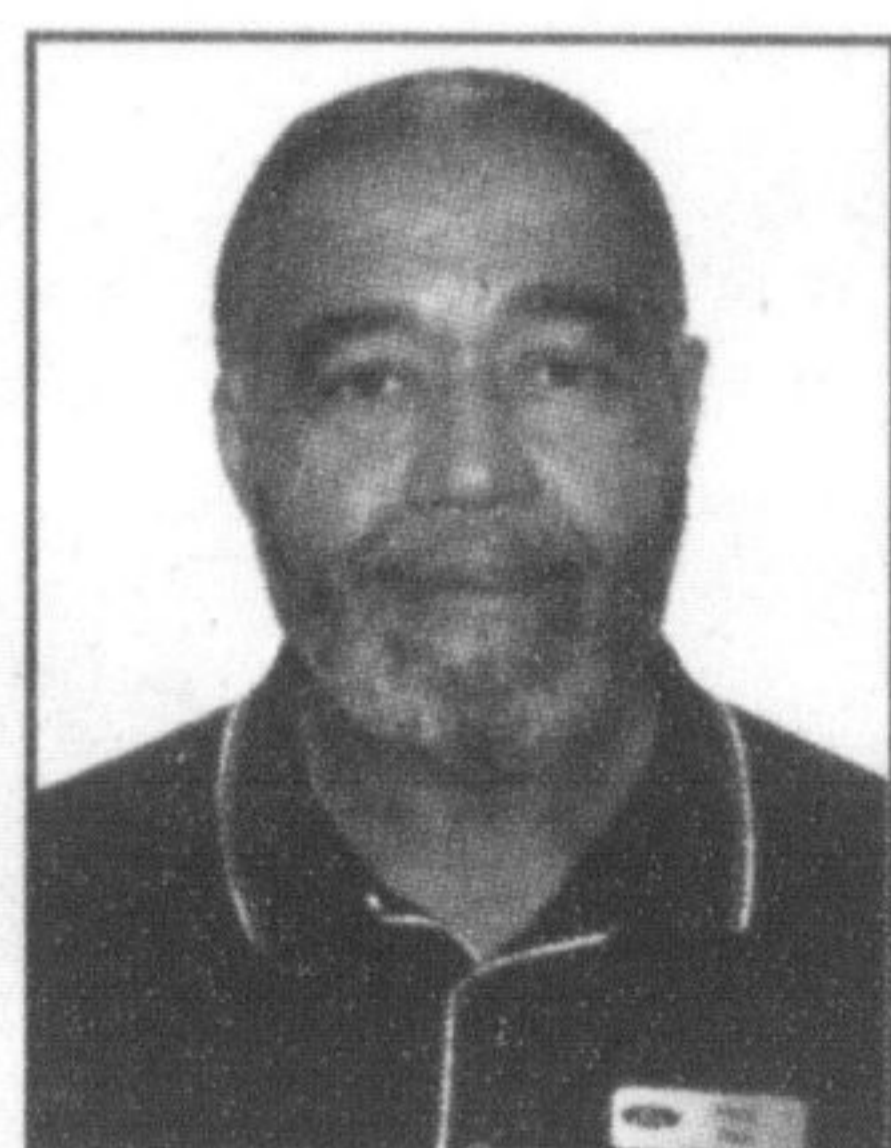

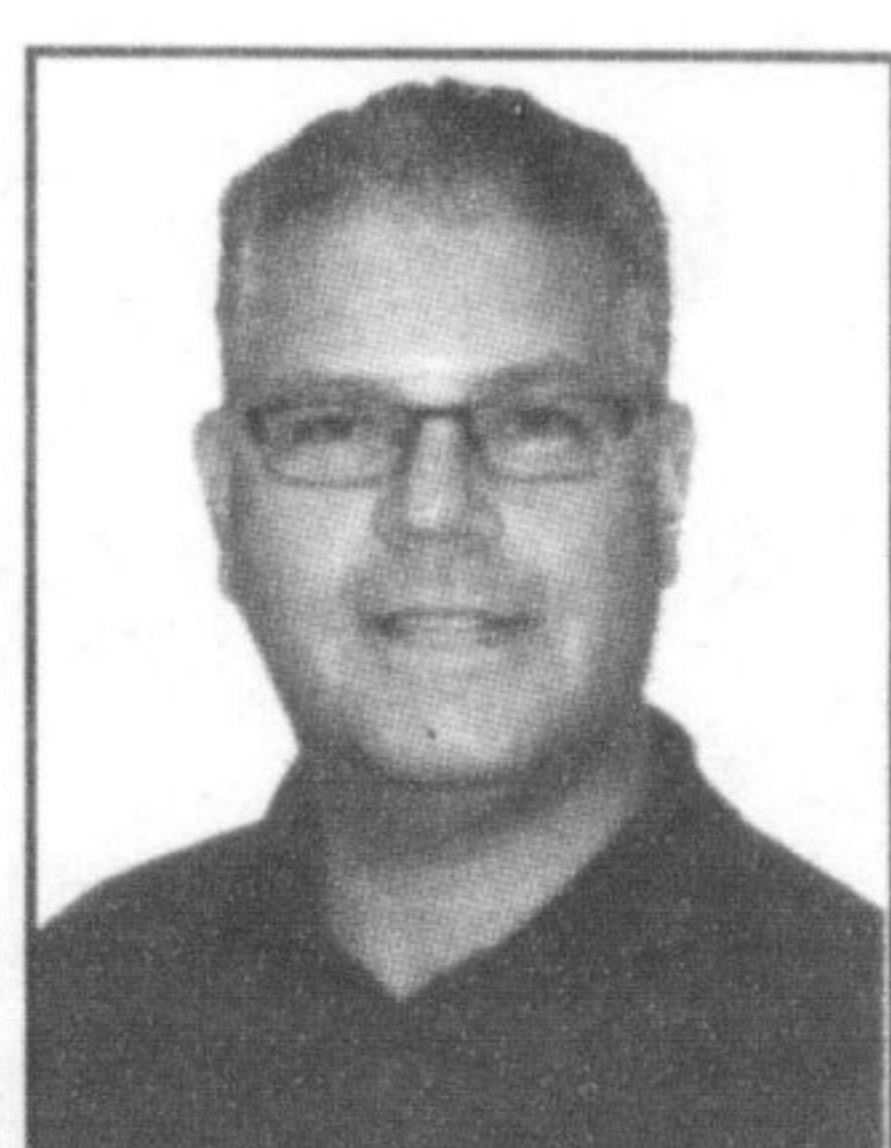
