The late-summer showcase drew roughly 350 competitors and featured a newly-added Olympic distance event (1,500 m swim, 40 km bike, 10 km run), which was won by Georgetown's Lesley Grice.

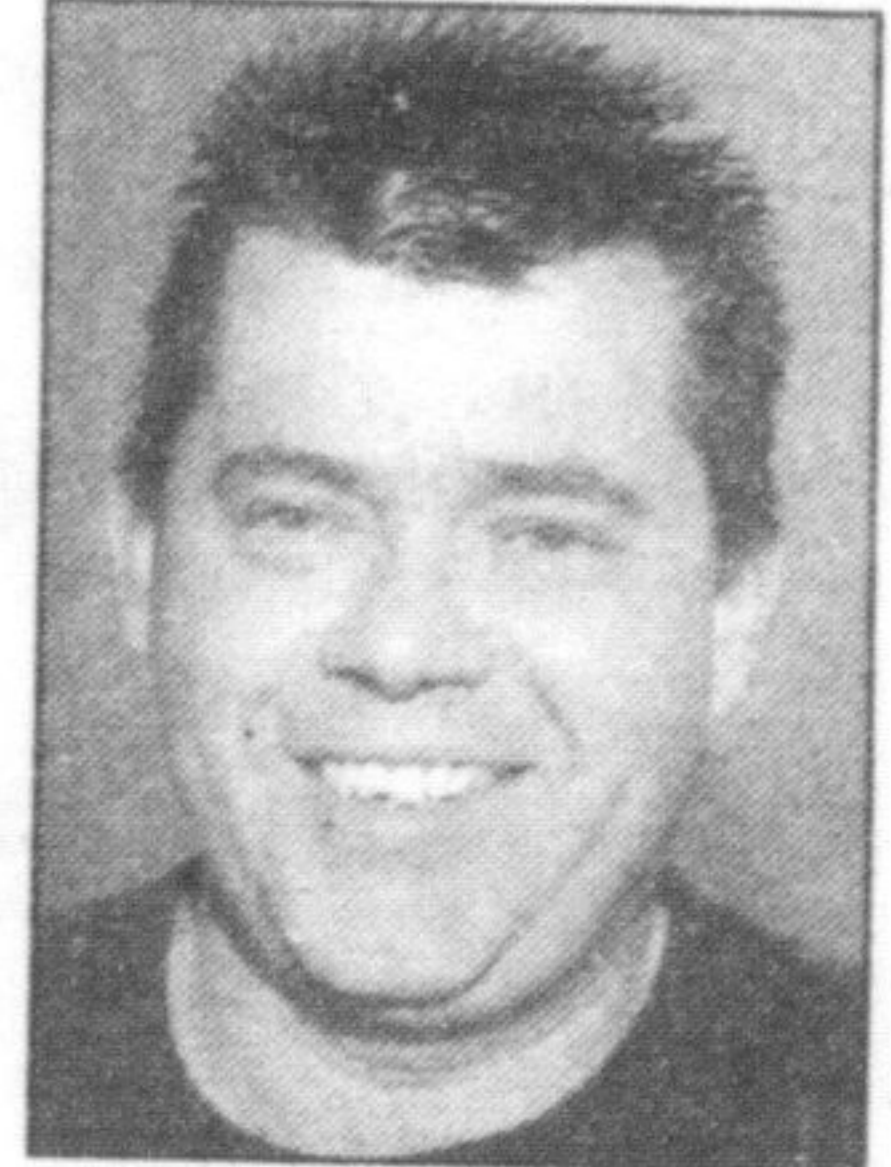

# Fletcher prevails in Peterboro
