



# Big finish gives Under-15 boys League Cup

#### Boys rally from two deficits to claim championship

The championship drought is over.

Refusing to come unraveled after falling behind twice in the first half at Hamilton's Mohawk Park Sunday afternoon, the Under-15 Magic boys eventually grounded the Mississauga Falcons 4-2 — giving Milton its first League Cup title in over a decade, perhaps longer.

The Bhandari Dentistry-sponsored Magic gave up a goal in the first five minutes of play, and found themselves trailing again at intermission—but maintained their composure each time.

"The guys didn't push the panic button. They

didn't deviate from our game plan — which is a strong defence and counter-attack — and that was the key to our success," said head coach Louie DiPalma, who took the Under-17 girls to back-to-back League Cup championship appearances in the late '90s. "It was a great team effort."

Zavvy Brown cemented the win with roughly five minutes to go, burying a 20-foot blast into the bottom left corner to complete a huge passing play with Heeva Sarkarrah and Sanjay Moodie.

This came just a few minutes after Richard Monk — returning from an ankle injury sustained three games earlier — came off the bench to deliver the game winner. He did so with a nifty off-the-


