

Solid debut for lawn bowling men's trio at novice provincials

A Milton men's lawn bowling trio may not have lasted long in their debut at the novice provincial championships this past weekend, but at least they didn't end up winless.

Kicking off their trip to Sarnia in style, the Norm Coulter-skipped team — with vice John Chow and lead David DeFoe — dumped Etobicoke's Robert Bartlett 27-13 Saturday morning.

"We pretty much carried that game all the way through," said Coulter,

whose trio earned a provincial berth by virtue of last month's district championship win in Port Credit.

While following that first-round triumph up with some competitive play, Coulter and company gave up a late six-point end in each of their last two round-robin games — costing them 27-19 and 22-13 losses to teams from Burlington and Woodstock.
